Location: Laurel Drive and Slater Drive

I hereby direct that This existing One-Way Stop Control on Garden Street with Laurel Drive designated as the preferential street, shall be converted to an All-Way Stop Control at the above-named location, in accordance with the associated details (WO 26-30, WO 26-31).


This regulation shall be effective upon posting.

Recommended by: Bruce Littleton, PTOE; County Traffic Engineering Manager (LCDOT)

Studies on file: Approved Engineering Report dated April 24, 2026, recommending the existing One-Way Stop Control be converted to an All-Way Stop Control. The traffic volumes indicate that Garden Street approach carries a significant portion of the traffic during school hours and in some hours exceeds the volume of the approaches on Laurel Drive. Under such conditions, the appropriate intersection control should be an "all-way" stop condition to more equably distribute the intersection traffic delays and provide stop control pedestrian access to the bus stop on the south side of Laurel Drive.
