Studies on file: Letter of Request dated December 14, 2016 from City of Bonita Springs requesting that a No Parking Zone be established the full length of Hickory Boulevard as a safety measure. The City Council in a December 7, 2016 meeting unanimously requested Lee County to authorize the No Parking zone within the City Limits. Currently No Parking signs are posted at beach accesses, transit bus pull-offs, and a few other limited areas. This measure will prohibit all parking within the right-of-way as requested.
