**Studies on file:** Prior 24-hour Intersection Approach Count. Approach volumes are relatively equal with the slightly higher volume street having the stop controls. Incremental traffic control measures have had marginal impact on reducing the incidence and severity of crashes. Since both streets are designated collector roads of similar character, and approach volumes are relatively equal, conversion to an All-Way Stop is consistent with "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control" criterion as a safety and operational measure.
