**Location:** Karen Avenue N. at 69<sup>th</sup>, 70<sup>th</sup>, 71<sup>st</sup>, 72<sup>nd</sup>, 73<sup>rd</sup>, and 74<sup>th</sup> Streets W.

**I hereby direct that the** existing Stop signs on Karen Avenue N. be reversed with Karen Avenue N. designated as the preferential street

at the above named location, in accordance with the attached detail.


**Studies on file:** Field observations of May 18, 2017. Karen Avenue between 68<sup>th</sup> and 75<sup>th</sup> Streets W is paved and in good condition. The area is an enclave with less than ten (10) percent of the residential parcels built on, and the side-streets terminate at LAMSID Canals on both sides of Karen Avenue. Stop signs are on place on Karen Avenue at each intersection. Presumably these were installed decades ago when roadway swales may have been present. Under existing conditions and MUTCD guidance, the minor side-streets should stop for the higher volume road. Therefore, it is recommended to reverse the stop controls at each of the six intersections to conform to MUTCD guidelines.
