Studies on file: Lee County Department of Transportation (DOT) has determined that August Street approaching Orange Grove Boulevard is a County-maintained public road. A short section was signed as non-County maintained and no control was in place at the intersection controlling the minor approach. Therefore, in accordance with the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices" and current DOT practice a stop control is appropriate to control the westbound side-street traffic and the "End of County Maintenance" sign is to be removed.
