AMENDED ROADWATCH UPDATE
September 19, 2024 to September 25, 2024

1. Road Work/Maintenance/Improvement

Corkscrew Road Widening Project – Phase I Construction Project: The project widens Corkscrew Road to six lanes from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Fire House Lane, and to four lanes from Fire House Lane to Bella Terra Boulevard. The project includes adding on-road bike lanes, some sidewalk, installing new drainage, and constructing a wildlife crossing approximately 1000 feet west of the entrance to Cypress Shadows Boulevard. This crossing will coincide with a regional flow-way that crosses Corkscrew Road at that location. The Village of Estero will be installing shared use paths, lighting, and landscaping as phasing allows. **Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone. Please be aware of shifts in travel lanes and bike lanes, sidewalk detours, and miscellaneous turn lane closures.**

*Please use caution and drive with courtesy and patience throughout the project area.
Residents are entering and exiting communities on both sides of Corkscrew Road.*

The following information is provided by Cougar Contracting, Inc.:

- Corkscrew Road is now in its final configuration from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Bella Terra Boulevard. Motorists should expect isolated flagging operations with periodic lane closures as the contractor works through the final project punch list. Motorists should also expect construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway.
- Crews continue installing signalization, striping, and fencing throughout the project.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

WORK PERFORMED BY OTHERS:

- The Village of Estero anticipates beginning construction of their shared use path in fall 2024. The path is designed to extend to the east property line of Bella Terra on the south side and to east of Grandezza on the north side of Corkscrew Road.

Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. **Estimated completion of the full project is summer 2024.** Project cost is approximately \$23 M. The contractor is Cougar Contracting, LLC. Corkscrew Road Widening Project – Phase 2 Construction Project: The project constructs four, 11-foot-wide travel lanes from Bella Terra Boulevard to just east of Alico Road, and a new traffic signal at the Alico Road intersection. Also included are on-road bike lanes in each direction, a 10-foot-wide shared-use path on the south side of the road, a 6-foot sidewalk on the north side of the road, and street lighting. The 22-foot wide (varies) median includes various hardwood and palm trees as well as shrubs.

**Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution
when traveling through the work zone.**

- Crews may be performing earthwork close to the roadway. Please be aware that trucks may be entering and leaving Corkscrew Road.
- Crews are installing water main from Wayside Lane to Alico Road.
- Crews are installing a force main on both sides of Corkscrew Road.
- During daytime hours, the contractor continues earthwork as a part of the new pond construction east of Corkscrew Shores.
- Crews are installing erosion control and traffic control devices throughout the project.
- Crews may be working close to the roadway. Motorists are asked to drive with caution. Sidewalks may be closed in areas throughout the project as the contractor performs underground work.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. Estimated completion is spring 2026. Project cost is approximately \$27 M. The contractor is Bergeron Land Development, Inc. For further questions, please visit the project website at

Sanibel Causeway Emergency Restoration: Crews have moved traffic to the permanent lanes on the Sanibel Causeway. **The causeway islands surrounding the temporary roadway are an active work zone and are currently closed for public access, including from the water.**

The following work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

East of the Toll Plaza:

- McGregor Boulevard is REDUCED TO ONE LANE IN EACH DIRECTION for approximately ½ mile from Shell Point Boulevard to west of Port Comfort Road. Both directions of travel are using the north side of the roadway. Later this fall traffic will be shifted to the south for crews to work on the north. This shift is necessary for the contractor to reconstruct an underground pipe crossing. The contractor expects to maintain one lane of travel in each direction through early 2025.
- Motorists should expect temporary daytime lane closures on McGregor Boulevard, both eastbound and westbound from Shell Point Boulevard to Punta Rassa Road for crews to move equipment and materials as necessary.
- Motorists should expect one lane of eastbound travel to continue from the toll plaza to Shell Point Road on the south (beach) side of McGregor Boulevard. The shoulder (south/beach side) remains FULLY CLOSED TO ACCESS. This closure is necessary for crews to excavate and install underground devices (marine mattresses) to reinforce the shoreline. This closure is expected to be in place through early fall 2024.

West of the Toll Plaza:

- Motorists should expect traffic to be intermittently stopped at the staging area entrance as equipment crosses the road with materials for work on the south side of McGregor Boulevard.
- Later this month, crews are scheduled to begin installing sod for roadway stabilization and pond construction. Crews continue earthwork and debris removal along the causeway islands. Please expect construction equipment periodically entering/leaving the travel lanes when necessary. The contractor is limiting this interruption during peak hours.
- The westbound merge location is now west of the toll plaza. Motorists are urged to use caution and obey the 20 MPH speed limit. Construction vehicles and equipment continue to enter/exit the staging area near this location.
- Crews continue work in the area of the off-island U-turn under Span A.

Many oversized vehicles are crossing the causeway to assist with recovery efforts on the island. Please be patient as travel may be slower than usual. Bicyclists are encouraged to utilize another mode of transportation to travel the causeway and pedestrians are not permitted on the Sanibel Causeway.

MOTORISTS ARE REMINDED TO OBEY THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT OF 20 MPH. Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. Big Carlos Pass Bridge Project – Construction Project: The project builds a new bridge over Big Carlos Pass, from Estrellita Drive on Fort Myers Beach to the Lovers Key State Park bayside entrance on Lovers Key. The new bridge will replace the existing moveable bridge over Big Carlos Pass with a fixed span

bridge that will provide a vertical navigation clearance of 60 feet. The new bridge will be constructed on the Gulf side of the existing bridge, and will include one travel lane in each direction, bicycle lanes, a six-foot-wide sidewalk along the north side of Estero Boulevard, and a 10-foot-wide shared use path along the south side of Estero Boulevard. A parking area with access to the Lovers Key State Park will be included on the southeast side of the bridge. The project also includes relocation of existing infrastructure for Lee County Utilities and Bonita Springs Utilities.

Boaters are reminded to avoid the construction equipment and the temporary trestle that is in the water.

Please use the channel when traveling through Big Carlos Pass.

Pedestrians and boaters are reminded to please stay out of the work zone.

- Pedestrians will be directed to use sidewalk on the north side of the roadway through the construction area.
- The contractor will continue driving additional piles for the bridge and construction of the trestle. The contractor will be building the bridge from this temporary trestle. Pile driving will continue through the duration of the project.
- Crews will continue performing earthwork throughout the project area.
- Trolley stops are available at the south entrance to Black Island (Lovers Key Resort) for those traveling to Fort Myers Beach and across the street from Black Island (Lovers Key Resort) for those traveling to Lovers Key and Bonita Springs. Travelers are asked to wait behind the concrete barrier until ready to board the trolley.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone as workers and construction vehicles are entering and leaving the roadway. Motorists should expect reduced speeds throughout the project area. Draw bridge will remain in operation during construction and motorists should be prepared to stop. **Fishing from the Big Carlos Pass Bridge is restricted due to construction activities.**

Estimated completion is summer 2026. Project cost is approximately \$90.8 M. The contractor is Superior Construction. Leisure Lane to Del Prado Boulevard N along US 41 - North Fort Myers (FDOT Permit #2022-H-192-00135): Accurate Drilling Systems, Inc. will be performing utility improvements **beginning Monday, October 30, 2023, and will continue through September 19, 2024.** Asphalt pavement, concrete sidewalk, concrete curbing, and utility improvements will be performed. US 41 will not have any lane closures. For

Littleton Road Widening Project from Corbett Road to US 41: The project widens Littleton Road from the Corbett Road roundabout east to US 41. The new road segment will include an 11-foot-wide travel lane in each direction and a 12-foot-wide center turn lane with landscaped planting islands. The project began in January 2024 with estimated completion in summer 2025. Project cost is approximately \$20 million. The contractor is Wright Construction Group, Inc.

- During the week of Monday, September 23, the Horizon Village driveway will be reduced to one lane for crews to install underground drainage structures. Flaggers will be onsite to assist motorists and access will be maintained.
- Motorists are advised that eastbound and westbound traffic have shifted to the south side of the corridor throughout the length of the project to allow crews to work on the north side.
- Crews continue to install drainage structures within the project limits. Motorists should expect to see flagging operations with minimal delays from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
- Motorists are advised that traffic may be heavy on weekdays from 7:00 to 8:30 AM and from 1:30 to 3:30 PM due to Littleton Elementary School traffic. Expect delays. Please choose an alternative route if possible.
- Two eastbound LeeTran bus stops on Littleton Road near Horizon Boulevard and Serendipity Boulevard are temporarily out of service. The bus stop on the corner of Littleton Road and US-41/North Cleveland Avenue near 7-Eleven is still in service.
- As requested by Windmill Village management, the driveway at Windmill Boulevard will remain closed until construction has progressed away from the area. Motorists entering and exiting Windmill Village are advised to continue using the Delft Avenue driveway during this closure.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Ortiz Avenue Widening from SR 884 (Colonial Boulevard) to SR 82 (Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard): This project consists of widening of Ortiz Avenue from 2 lanes to 4 lanes and constructs a six-foot sidewalk on the east side of the road and a 10-foot paved trail on the west side of the road. An on-road bike lane on both sides of the road will also be included. New street lighting will be installed, and a grass median will separate traffic. No improvements will be made at the roundabout intersection with Hanson Street. The contractor will reconstruct the roadway with drainage improvements and stormwater management facilities. Work also includes installation of new water main and installation of new reclaimed water and sewer facilities for Lee County and the City of Fort Myers.

**Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution
when traveling through the work zone.**

- Motorists should expect northbound lane closures at the north end of the project for crews to install utilities. This includes the right turn lane into the RaceTrac gas station. Motorists will still be able to make all movements from the open lanes.
- Motorists should expect traffic to be intermittently stopped for crews to move material and equipment across the road.
- LeeTran has installed a new temporary northbound bus stop just south of the Lee County Jail driveway. The northbound stops just north of the Lee County Jail driveway and near RaceTrac are temporarily out of service.
- Crews will continue earthwork activities.
- The contractor is scheduled to survey the project during daytime hours.
- Crews will be installing force main and water main north and south of the roundabout.
- The contractor is identifying existing utility locations throughout the project.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Motorists are asked to drive with caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the work zone. **Estimated completion is Spring 2026.** Project cost is approximately \$31 M. Ben Hill Griffin Parkway Force Main Improvements - Fort Myers (ROW2023-01519): Accurate Drilling Systems, Inc. will be performing installation of 18" force main **beginning on Thursday, March 4, 2024, and continuing through October 31, 2024.** The outside (right) lane of northbound traffic on Ben Hill Griffin Boulevard, between FGCU Lake Parkway W and Corkscrew Road, will be subject to lane closures. The closures will be in sections as we advance with the Concrete Sidewalk Restoration. The closure of the northbound right lane will occur between the hours of **9:00 AM to 3:30 PM** on weekdays. Buckingham Road in front of Oakview Community – Fort Myers (ROW2024-03292): Mitchell & Stark Construction Company is scheduled to carry out roadway improvements, with construction set to commence during the week of **May 20, 2024, and continuing through November 22, 2024**. The current two-lane configuration in the area will necessitate periodic lane closures throughout the construction period. Daytime work will be conducted now that we are out of season. The planned activities within the right-of-way (ROW) area include jack and boring underneath Buckingham Road, milling and paving, as well as the addition of a deceleration lane and a turn lane. Monday, June 24, 2024, and continuing through November 27, 2024. The intersection of Ray Avenue S and Meadow Road will be subject to lane closures. Three Oaks Parkway Extension Project Phase 1 from Fiddlesticks Canal to Indian Paint Lane: This project consists of extending Three Oaks Parkway north of the Fiddlesticks Canal and constructs 4 lanes with a 5-foot-wide bicycle lane. NE 3rd Terrace at Del Prado Boulevard N – Cape Coral (ROW2024-00352): M.E. Construction, Inc. will be replacing a water main **beginning Tuesday, July 9, 2024, and continuing through Friday, November 22, 2024.** A water main will be replaced on NE 3rd Terrace between NE 15th Place and NE 16th Place, crossing under Del Prado Boulevard. Roadway restoration will follow the water main work. There will be lane and road closures around the intersection of Del Prado Boulevard N and NE 3rd Terrace. From southbound Del Prado Boulevard N, the left turn lane to NE 3rd Terrace will be closed. Eastbound NE 3rd Terrace will be closed from Del Prado Boulevard N to NE 16th Place.
