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Lee Commissioners approve contracts to repave roadways in Lehigh Acres and Bonita Springs

Fort Myers, FL, Nov. 19, 2024 – The Lee Board of County Commissioners continued its commitment Tuesday to countywide infrastructure by awarding a \$1.7 million contract to pave 25.1 lane miles in northern Lehigh Acres.

Contractor OHLA USA, Inc. is expected to begin work in January to resurface more than 50 road segments in the area.

Lee County Department of Transportation maintains about 1,500 miles of paved roads in Lehigh Acres. Contracts are typically approved throughout the fiscal year.

Each year, certain roads in Lehigh Acres are ranked and selected for paving based on road conditions and the number of residences on the road.

In another vote Tuesday, commissioners awarded a more than \$1 million contract to Ajax Paving Industries of Florida, LLC to resurface Bonita Beach Road from Kings Kew to west of Fish Trap Bay Bridge in Bonita Springs. That project consists of 2.23 lane miles of resurfacing. Work is expected to begin next spring.
