Roadwatch Update
June 16, 2022 – June 22, 2022

1. Road Work/Maintenance/Improvement

Striping Maintenance: Lee County DOT will be performing a moving operation with traffic delays on **6-16-22 through 6-22-22** between the hours of **9:00 AM to 4:00 PM** (weather permitting) on the following roadways:

Night work scheduled for Thursday June 16, 2022: Between the hours of **8:00 PM to 4:00 AM** (weather permitting), Lee County DOT Traffic will be refreshing the pavement markings at the following locations: (1) Boy Scout Drive; (2) Estero Boulevard @ Crescent Street. Intermittent lane closures and delays are expected.

Winkler Road, Fort Myers (ROW2020-00484): Mastec Utility Services will be working for FPL installing new poles and transferring underground lines from old poles to new poles beginning on **Monday, November 29, 2021 and continuing through June 2022**. Work will take place from **9:00 AM to 3:00 PM** and some nighttime work may be included. There will be no lane closures; however, Mastec will be setting down mats to get bucket trucks to the poles. Burnt Store Road from Tropicana Parkway to Pine Island Road: This project consists of widening Burnt Store Road to four lanes. The project also includes construction of a new bridge over Shadroe Canal, drainage installation, and lighting. Motorists should expect **intermittent Northbound and Southbound lane closures during nighttime/overnight hours**, weather permitting. Motorists should use caution while driving in the area. This south segment from Tropicana Parkway to Pine Island Road costs \$13.6 million. The contractor is Wright Construction. The project is expected to be **completed by late Fall 2022**. **Beginning on June 19, motorists should expect a new traffic pattern where the northbound traffic will be shifted onto the newly constructed lanes.** For questions, please contact Lisa Macias at (239) 337-1071.

Corkscrew Road Widening Project – Phase I Construction Project: The project widens Corkscrew Road to six lanes from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Fire House Lane, and to four lanes from Fire House Lane to Bella Terra Boulevard. The project includes adding on-road bike lanes, some sidewalk, installing new drainage, and constructing a wildlife crossing approximately 1000 feet west of the entrance to Cypress Shadows Boulevard. This crossing will coincide with a regional flow-way that crosses Corkscrew Road at that location. Once the project is completed, the Village of Estero will be installing shared use paths, lighting, and landscaping. **Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone. Please be aware of shifts in travel lanes and bike lanes, sidewalk detours, miscellaneous turn lane closures, and uneven pavement throughout the project.**

Corkscrew motorists should expect slower than usual traffic when approaching The Preserve and Wild Blue as work is occurring in the communities' entrances.

The following work activities are scheduled to occur, weather permitting.

- **During the nighttime/overnight hours of 9 PM to 5 AM on Monday, June 20, 2022 through Wednesday, June 22, 2022**, crews will be installing the signal arms over the roadway at Corkscrew Road and Ben Hill Griffin Parkway. Motorists should expect long delays as crews must close movements throughout the intersection during these times. Motorists are urged to use Alico Road during this work.
- **During the nighttime/overnight hours of 9 PM to 5 AM on Monday, June 20, 2022 through Wednesday, June 22, 2022**, flaggers will be onsite to assist motorists near Bella Terra Boulevard. Crews will be demolishing existing curb in the medians. The left turn lanes will be closed for this work. Flaggers will be onsite to assist motorists.
- The contractor continues underground work in the driveway of **The Preserve at Corkscrew (Cypress Shadows Boulevard)**. Crews are currently working in the entrance. The exit is open to two-way travel. Once this work is complete, the contractor will move to work in the exit and both directions of travel will use the entrance. **The contractor is expecting to switch traffic on Monday, June 27, 2022. Work in the entrance is expected to continue until early/mid July.** Unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.
- **Currently motorists using Wild Blue Boulevard should expect two-way traffic to use the community's entrance (east side).** Work in the Wild Blue exit is anticipated to continue through early July 2022.
- Crews continue **construction of the bridge/wildlife crossing** between Wild Blue Boulevard and The Preserve at Corkscrew that will allow animals to cross under Corkscrew Road, similar to the crossing just east of Alico Road. A 10-foot-high fence will be installed to funnel the wildlife to cross at this location. Currently crews are constructing box culverts near the bridge/crossing that convey water under the roadway. Motorists should be aware of vehicles entering/exiting the road in this area.
- Bicyclists should expect the bike lane from Stoneybrook Golf Drive to just east of Wildcat Run to be combined with the travel lane while crews work on the north side of the road.
- Pedestrians must use the temporary walkway on the south side of Corkscrew Road from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Stoneybrook Golf Drive.

- Currently in the area between Wild Blue Boulevard and Cypress Shadows Boulevard (The Preserve at Corkscrew) vehicles are using temporary lanes on the north side of the road to allow crews to work on the south side of Corkscrew Road.
- Turn lanes are currently unavailable at Wild Blue Boulevard and Cypress Shadows Boulevard (The Preserve at Corkscrew).

Crews are installing curb, drainage, and sod, as well as performing earthwork, and relocating utilities. **MOTORISTS ARE REMINDED TO OBEY THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT.** Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. **Estimated completion is late 2023.** Project cost is approximately \$23 M. Del Prado Boulevard & SE 47th Terrace, Cape Coral: Lee County DOT, along with their contractor American Infrastructure Services (AIS), will be installing a new traffic signal mast arm at Del Prado Boulevard and Southeast 47th Terrace. This project includes a new mast arm and removing two of the existing mast arms. reFRESH Estero Boulevard/Waterlines – Albatross Street to the south end of the Island:

Contractors for Fort Myers Beach and Lee County are installing new water main, and sanitary sewer force main, storm drainage, sidewalk, and rebuilding roadway on Estero Boulevard from Albatross Street to the south end of the Island. Motorists may experience daytime and nighttime intermittent one-lane traffic on Estero Boulevard. Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays. Motorists may experience momentary delays while crews move materials for the construction activities. Crews are expected to work **Monday through Friday and most Saturdays.**

Albatross Street to the south end of the island. Motorists may experience daytime lane shifts on Estero Boulevard while crews complete punch list items. Sanibel Causeway Island “B” Shoreline Stabilization Project: Lee County’s contractor, Spectrum Contracting, Inc., is providing services to stabilize the shoreline on Island “B”. The project consists of

clearing exotic vegetation along the shoreline, excavating some existing stone that will be reused, placement of new beach sand, and construction of “T-Groins”. Expect large vehicles entering and exiting the roadway. Drivers and pedestrians should use extra caution in this area. The project is expected to be complete in **Spring 2022**. Sanibel Bridge Span A Inspections: Lee County DOT and their consultant Hardesty and Hannover will perform inspection activities on the Sanibel Bridge Span A over Sanibel Causeway. During the inspection duration, sporadic lane shifts will be necessary. Therefore, motorists and pedestrians are urged to use extra caution. The activities will be on **July 14, 2022**. Caloosa Site Development Dollar General Store #23109 (ROW2022-00072) Caloosa Site Development, Inc. will be performing concrete sidewalk and other improvements beginning **Monday March 7, 2022 and continue through July 31, 2022**. The westbound lane of Palm Beach Boulevard (S.R. 80) at the corner of New York Drive will be affected. No lane closures are anticipated, although site work will be close to the outside travel lane. Motorist caution is advised when traveling through this area. US 41/Cleveland Avenue from Winkler Avenue to SR 82/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard Construction Project: Crews will be installing and relocating utilities and constructing medians on US 41/Cleveland Avenue from Winkler Avenue to SR 82.

- **Expect Canal Street (both sides) closed at US 41/Cleveland Avenue.**
- **Expect Victoria Avenue closed on the east side of US 41/Cleveland Avenue.**
- **Expect Hopple Street closed on the east side of US 41/Cleveland Avenue.**
- **Motorists should expect side road closures from Winkler Avenue to Victoria Avenue throughout the duration of the project.**
- **Motorists should expect intermittent northbound and southbound lane closures and detours on US 41/Cleveland Avenue during daytime and nighttime/overnight hours Monday through Friday throughout the duration of the project.**

Additional work includes installing drainage structures, pedestrian signals, upgrading signals and lighting, and resurfacing existing highway. The project will be constructed in three segments. Each segment will have most of the construction completed prior to moving to the next segment. Construction will begin on the first segment from Winkler Avenue to Carrell Road. Crews will work on the west side of the road initially and when that work is completed, they will shift to the east side of Cleveland Avenue/US 41. The expected project completion is **Spring 2023**.

North Lee County Wellfield Expansion Phase IIIA Project – Fort Myers (ROW2022-00030):

Nalle Grade Road between Slater Road to Nalle Road - RPU is installing a Raw Water Main and Fiber Optics Conduit via directional drill from **February 28, 2022 through September 30, 2022**. Directional Drill will be performed along Nalle Grade Road from Slater Road heading East towards Nalle Road. Eastbound lane along Nalle Grade Road from Slater Road to Nalle Road will be subject to temporary daily lane closures or permanent lane closures. Traffic will be maintained with either temporary traffic signals or flagmen depending on which MOT is used. For further information, please contact Victor G. Slater Road from Nalle Grade Road to Rich Road - RPU has completed the open cut and HDD installation work. RPU will continue with the restoration of the swales and driveway repair that will begin on **June 6, 2022 through June 17, 2022**. Work will be in the swale but lanes will be closed sporadically throughout the day. RPU will be using flagmen throughout the day to direct traffic when the travel lane is closed to perform the work. The projected start date is **Tuesday, April 12, 2022 and will continue through Saturday, June 25, 2022**. The said

sections of road will be subject to a lane closure with flaggers between **9:00 AM and 4:30 PM**, and Area Wide Protective will be providing MOT services. Sanibel Causeway Bridge Structure: Starting **April 18, 2022 and ending on November 24, 2022** from **9:00 AM to 4:00 PM**, Lee County will be making repairs to the Sanibel Causeway Bridge Structure span C, over San Carlos Bay. All the work will be performed over the bridge on a snoop truck. Lee County will do several "Lane Shifts" with no lane closures.

Crystal Drive (Plantation Road to US 41) Water Main Improvements (ROW 2022-00020): Beginning **April 4, 2022**, contractors for Lee County will install new water main beginning on the west side of Planation Road just south of the roundabout with Crystal Drive. Then install the water main on the south side of Crystal Drive from Plantation Road to US 41 to tie into a connection point on the east side of US 41 just south of Crystal Drive. Crews will also install water main from a connection point on the east side of US 41 near 12499 Cleveland Avenue (PDQ). Then continue east to Austin Street and west under US 41 to the north side of Brantley Road and tie into a connection point between Pine Grove and Brantley Pines driveways. Crews are expected to work **7 AM to 7 PM**. This project is expected to be completed in **Summer of 2023**.

Drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists should use caution and be aware of construction equipment and vehicles entering/exiting streets in the project area.
