#### **EACKGROUND:** (Continued)

In this instance, H&K is representing IMC Phosphates Company in the "Charlotte County" litigation in which, Lee County is an intervening party.

Under the Florida Bar rules, if a law firm is representing clients with potentially adverse interests, the firm may represent both entities only if the representation will not adversely affect either party due to the nature of the representations after consultation with both clients, and their informed consent.

Mr. Vogel has indicated in his attached April 6, 2004 letter that due to the nature of his particular representation of the County in the County's bond issues and the nature of the matters involved in the IMC matter, the County's interests will not be adversely affected nor compromised. Lawyers in the IMC case have no contact with Mr. Vogel and vice versa. No information or confidentiality will be shared between H&K lawyers for either Lee County or IMC on either matters.

A "waiver of conflicts" letter from H&K is attached, already executed by IMC, for the Board's consideration and execution.

The County Attorney's Office recommends granting the waiver based upon the factual circumstances and the representations of H&K counsel.
