

# You don't need an ID card for Aetna Dental

Good news. Life just got simpler. You no longer need a member ID card to get care with Aetna Dental.

Dental ID cards are generally not required by providers, they rely on rosters or online patient eligibility and benefit information to verify eligibility. **Effective March 1, Aetna will stop mailing Dental PPO or DMO ID cards.** Members can continue to use the cards they have, this will impact new member/dependent enrollment and members who make any significant changes (i.e. name) that would trigger a new card.

Any new hire received prior to 02/28 will receive an ID card, any new hire received after; will receive a letter not an ID card. Attached is a copy of the member letter.

## Why the change?

We want to make doing business with us easier than ever. Plus, no card means no plastic and that's better for the environment – and good for everyone.

## How will my dentist know I'm an Aetna Dental PPO member?

When you go to your dentist, tell the office your name, date of birth and Member ID# (or your social security number). Or, show them this letter.

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
#### But what if I want a card?
