SATURDAY MORNING UPDATE FROM LEE COUNTY GOVERNMENT – Hurricane Elsa

Fort Myers, FL, July 3, 2021 – Lee County Public Safety-Emergency Management today continues to monitor Hurricane Elsa and make plans. The county will make decisions regarding activation levels at the Emergency Operations Center based on the forecast. Given this morning's updated forecast from the National Weather Service, we do not anticipate making that decision until this afternoon at the earliest.

There is no State of Local Emergency declared at this time.
