

Lee County Government open Tuesday for normal operations

Fort Myers, FL, July 5, 2021 – The Lee County Public Safety-Emergency Management staff and others have been monitoring Tropical Storm Elsa throughout the holiday weekend.

Using information from partners such as the National Weather Service as well as local partners and departmental expertise, the county will be open Tuesday. This includes normal operations and business hours.

There are a few exceptions, such as those county sites in leased structures. For example, both the Johann Fust Community Library in Boca Grande and the Captiva Memorial Library will be closed.

Also, to clear up any confusion:

- Chief Judge Michael McHugh has authorized the closure of all courthouses in the 20th Circuit Tuesday. All courthouses are expected to resume operations on Wednesday.
