Project Description: The project cost of this USC Section 5339 Bus and Bus Facilities Formula Program grant is estimated at \$758,288 for the federal share portion of FY 2020 appropriation available under Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act. Program funds will be matched with the state of Florida Department of Transportation's Transportation Development Credit.

Proposed projects include funding for Paratransit ADA vehicle replacements.
