PROJECT NARRATIVE

Sitework

The site encompasses approximately 23 acres of pasture land to be developed with full storm drainage including onsite retention areas; water, sewer and fire line utilities; asphalt and concrete paving for parking and drive aisles; sidewalks; pavers; full perimeter fencing with automatic gate operators; 100% coverage irrigation and landscaping; site lighting and related site and directional signage.

Buildings

Typical For All Includes conventional shallow earth formed foundations, slab-on-grade with tilt-wall exterior wall panels, structural steel framing, bar joists and a composite metal deck with lightweight insulating concrete. The roof system is a modified bitumen system. Interior walls are metal framing with drywall and orange peel texture. Also included are curtainwall window systems; hollow metal doors and frames and wood doors with associated hardware; and all typical specialties and accessories for bathrooms, conference areas, offices, break rooms and copy rooms. The fire protection system is an automatic wet pipe system. The plumbing system consists of standard sensor-flow fixtures and standard supply and sewer piping. The mechanical system consists of packaged rooftop units and all associated ancillary requirements. The electrical system is fed from the maintenance building and includes a complete distribution system. protection, grounding and TVSS systems are all included. The following low voltage systems are included: data/communications, cable TV, fire alarm, security intrusion, security cameras, intercom system, and card access systems.

Building

Administration Single story building with approximately 11,750 gross square feet. above description for all details. The roof system on the Administration Building includes a structural concrete slab under the lightweight insulating concrete.

Operations Building

Single story building with approximately 21,640 gross square feet. above description for all details.

Maintenance Single story building with approximately 45,156 gross square feet.

Building

above description for all details. The Maintenance Building includes a center vaulted clearstory area to accommodate day lighting in the maintenance areas. The maintenance area also includes all shop equipment, an overhead rail crane, in-ground and slab mounted lifts, storage room shelving, a complete fluid distribution and waste recovery system, compressed air system, and vehicle emission exhaust system.

Fuel & Detail Building

Single story tilt-wall and bar joist construction for the air conditioned space with a pre-engineered metal building for the dive lanes with approximately 8,417 gross square feet of under roof space. The Fueling Area includes unleaded and diesel fuel storage tanks, two fueling lanes with dispensers and monitoring system. Also included is fluid dispensing and compressed air. The detail area includes a vacuum station, storage spaces, washer and dryer.

Wash Building

Single story pre-engineered metal building with metal wall panels on the north elevation and tilt-wall panel infill on the south elevation and opened ends with approximately 5,794 gross square feet. The Wash Area includes two bus wash lanes (one new and one relocated) with the associated water recycling equipment.


