LeeTran announces off-season schedule changes

Fort Myers, FL, May 15, 2020 – Two bus routes will return to their off-season schedules beginning Monday, May 18, affecting Bonita Springs and LeeTran's connection with Collier Area Transit (CAT).

- Route 150, serving Bonita Springs and Lovers Key State Park, will run on an off-season Sunday schedule
- Route 600, serving Bonita Springs and connecting with Collier Area Transit (CAT), will run on an off-season Sunday schedule
