Fire Protection	\$ 200.00 per well
Multi-Residence Rental (Duplex, Triplex, etc.)	\$ 275.00 per well
Permit Time Extension	\$ 100.00
Permit Application Late Fee	\$ 50.00
Repair permit Residential Well	\$ 200.00
Repair permit Commercial Well	\$ 275.00

Drilling	\$ 150.00 per shaft

Well Plugging

First Reinspection Fee	\$ 100.00
Second Reinspection Fee	\$ 150.00
Third Reinspection Fee	\$ 200.00
After Hour Inspection	\$ 65.00 per hour

LICENSE FEES

Geotechnical Boring or Elevator Shaft	
Contractor License or License Renewal	\$ 100.00 every 2 years
Late Fee for License Renewal	\$ 100.00

The Division will consider waiving the fee for the Permit only if the original contractor is performing the proposed repair or change of use within one year of the well construction. The division will review each request on a case by case basis.
