Baseball Tournament Rules

- 1. All varsity games will be 9 inning games unless the same two teams are playing a doubleheader that day. All doubleheaders with the same teams playing will be 7 inning games. The decision to play two 9 inning games, 9/7 or 7/9 inning games <u>must be agreed upon by both coaches</u> before the start of the first game of the doubleheader.
- 2. All varsity games must complete at least 7 innings with the exception being games stopped due to inclement weather.
- 3. Varsity Games: There is no ten run rule except after 7 innings and then <u>ONLY</u> with mutual consent of both coaches as agreed to with the home plate umpire during ground rules prior to the start of game. If both coaches do not agree then a full game will be played.
- 4. All junior varsity games will be 7 inning games or have a two hour time limit (whichever occurs first).
- 5. There is no time limit in varsity games.
- 6. The home team will be designated through a coin toss conducted by the coaches before the game. <u>Exception</u>: If two teams are playing a doubleheader against the same team, the home team of the first game will be the visiting team for the second game.
- 7. Coaches may take infield and outfield prior to the start of their game. Please ensure your players clear the infield when the grounds crew arrives to fix up the field. Please note the field will not be fixed again prior to the start of your game.
- 8. Stoppage of games due to inclement weather is at the discretion of the Gene Cusic Collegiate Classic staff and the umpires.
- 9. Terry Park and Player Development Complex are equipped with a Lightning Alerting System.
 - a. Seek safe shelter in an enclosed vehicle and enclosed & grounded buildings.
 - b. Avoid bleachers, dugouts, pavilions, tall trees, metal fences, open areas and picnic shelters

10. Batting Cages

- a. All pre-game batting practice should be done in the batting cages. Metal cleats are prohibited in the batting cages.
- b. Batting cages are on a first come basis and limited to one tunnel when other teams are waiting.
- 11. Coaches are to ensure all players stay in the dugouts or are outside of the field fencing. Staff and umpires will ensure all teams are in compliance.
- 12. Threats toward umpires, coaches, players, and/or staff will result in the enforcement of NCAA Rules regarding unsportsmanlike conduct. The appropriate forms will be filed and your college/university will be notified.
- 13. Coolers for ice and water
 - a. Terry Park: Teams are able to fill up their coolers or borrow and fill a Lee County cooler. The coolers, ice, and water are located in the room next to the air conditioning unit between fields 2 and 4. If you are unsure of where that is, please stop by the building located directly behind the stadium for further directions.
 - b. Lee County Player Development Complex: Coolers with ice and water will be provided in all of the dugouts.
- 14. Please remove all trash and gear from your dugout after each game.
