



Caloosahatchee Regional Park Campground Rules



To make your stay more enjoyable and for the safety of all park visitors and natural inhabitants, please abide by the following guidelines:

Pets, alcohol, and fireworks are not permitted in the park.

PARKING PASSES: Each vehicle in your party must display a parking pass. Obtain the proper number of parking passes for your group upon check-in. Each family site receives 2 complimentary passes; each group/equestrian site receives 4 complimentary passes. If there are more vehicles in your group than passes, the remaining cars will need to pay the \$5.00 daily rate per vehicle cash or check only. Bring exact change. As the campsite applicant, you can pay for all of the additional vehicle passes or ask your guests to cover the parking fee. Parking passes should be displayed on the vehicle dashboard.

EQUIPMENT: Do not move picnic tables, grills or fire rings. Food trucks or trailers, bounce houses and other recreational equipment must be pre-approved by the site supervisor.

BIKES: Bicycles are permitted on the campground road and on the mountain biking trails across the street. See a park map for more information. Children under the age of 16 are required by law to wear a helmet. Helmets are recommended for all riders. Trails on the south side of the park are designated as hiking trails only.

FIREWOOD: No cutting or scarring of standing trees or other live vegetation. Do not collect downed wood or branches in wooded areas of the park. Firewood is available for a donation. Firewood brought with you must fit within the fire ring and cannot be pallet material, pressure treated wood or contain nails. Chainsaws are not permitted. Fires **MUST** be attended at all times. Do not burn your trash. Campfires **MAY** BE banned in the dry season.

TRASH: All trash must be disposed of in the dumpster or recycle bin in the campground parking lot.

GEAR CARTS: Gear carts are available for the transportation of your equipment and trash to and from your site. Please return them when you are finished using them so other visitors may use them. No one is allowed to ride in the carts. Motorized vehicles are not permitted in the park beyond the paved parking lots.

QUIET HOURS AND PRIVATE PROPERTY: Neighbor privacy is expected at all times. Please respect our private property neighbors by not approaching fence lines, accessing private drives or any private property. Quiet hours in the campground are from 10:00pm to 7:00am every night. Loud music is prohibited.

SAFETY: Do not climb trees, approach or feed wildlife at the park. Do not leave your valuables or food unattended. Swimming in the river along the park shoreline is not permitted.

PARK GATES: The campground gate hours vary during season 7:00am to 6:00pm Sunday –Thursday and from 7:00am until 10:00pm on Friday and Saturday. (Summer hours 7:00am to 7:30pm Sunday-Thursday). Refer to the park web site for the main entrance and north side entrance gate hours.

CHECK IN AND OUT: Check in is anytime after noon on the day of your arrival. Check out is at 12:00pm (noon) on the day of your departure.

I understand the rules as I have read, or as have been explained to me. I will explain these rules to everyone in my group. Failure to adhere to these rules by anyone in my group, excessive trash, destruction or damage to facilities or equipment shall be cause for the park to refuse future reservations and/or charges filed against me for damages.
