Mom and daughter explore the lives of otters and even touch its fur.

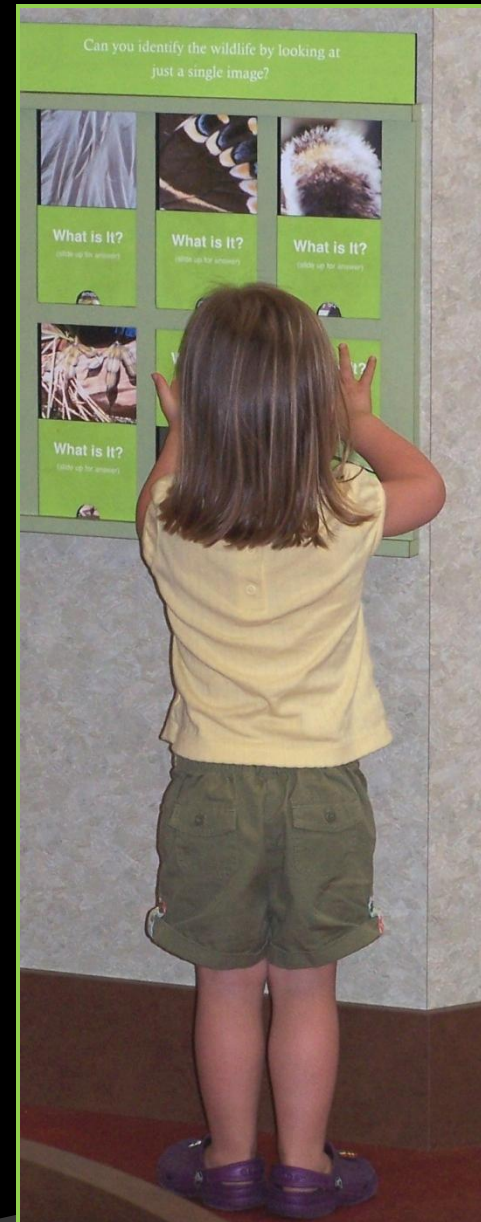


Students learn information about local flora and fauna and the habitats they reside in.

Hints for finding wildlife are included.



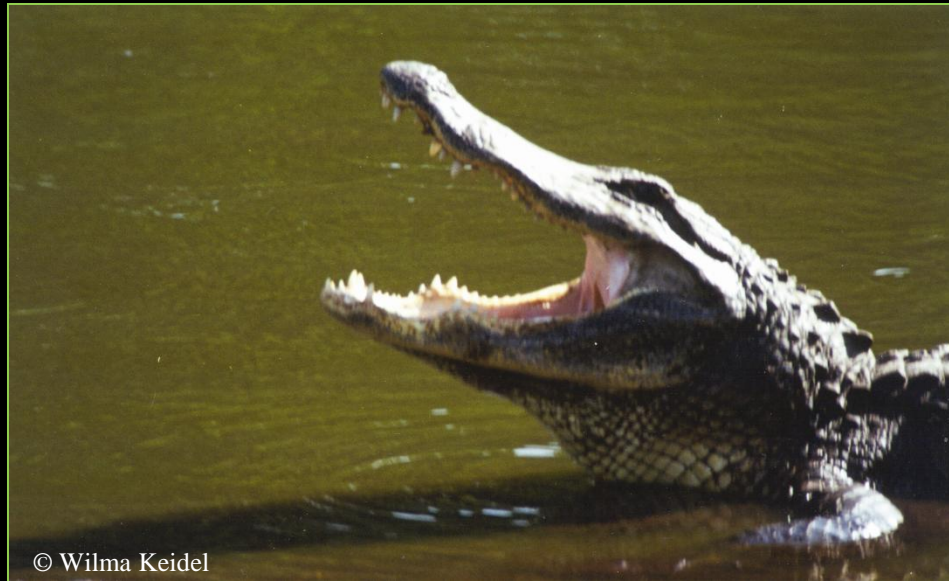
Displays allow
