Here are a few suggestions to remember when preparing your camper for camp each morning:

- ◆ Mark all belongings with camper's name. (Water bottles, clothes, towels, etc.)
- ◆ Send a swimsuit, water shoes, and towel every Tuesday, and we will keep it throughout the week. We'll send it home with your camper on Friday.
- ◆ Send a refillable water bottle to use every day during outside activities.
- ◆ Campers must wear closed-toed athletic shoes and socks every day.
- ◆ Put sunscreen on your child before they come to camp and send sunscreen with them.

PARENTS, participants will only be released to the authorized person on the supplemental sheets. **Come in to sign your campers in and out** and be ready to show I.D.
