2. **QUESTIONS/ANSWERS**

1.	On sheet 19 of the solicitation, it states “Millings from this project shall be the property of the Vendor”. Is the contractor the “vendor” in this, or is Lee County keeping the millings?
<b>Answer</b>	<b>As with all of our projects, terms including Vendor, Contractor, and the like, are for the company signing the agreement with the County. The term County is for Lee County. For this project, the Vendor is keeping any millings.</b>
2.	I see that this is a 60 day project, but just have a question about lead time for all the signalization items on this project. It could take 90 to 120 days to get the 19 EA Ped poles and other material. How will this be addressed?
<b>Answer</b>	<b>120-day timeframe to gather supplies then 60 days to do the actual work.</b>
3.	In reviewing the bid documents for the project, can you please clarify the correct “FY”. Bid documents have the FY as 22. Is this correct? If not, how should we correct?
<b>Answer</b>	<b>For this project, FY 22 has two meanings. The project scope was originally discussed and slated for 2022 but was pushed back until recently. Also, the funds to cover this project were originally from 2022. When we plan out work, projects are given letters and numbers to represent what year the funding is from and what type of roadway it is as well as which order the projects go in. The numbers are correct, and no change is necessary.</b>
