TITLE: Award Contract for Sodium Bisulfite 40% Aqueous Solution

I. MOTION REQUESTED

- A. Award Invitation to Bid No. B180243RJD, Annual Sodium Bisulfite 40% Aqueous Solution, to Thatcher Chemical of Florida, Inc., the responsible bidder with the lowest responsive bid, for the annual supply of Sodium Bisulfite 40% Aqueous Solution on an as needed basis to Lee County Utilities, as approved in the department's annual adopted budget, for an initial period of one year.
- B. Authorize the Chair to execute the contract documents on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners.
- C. Grant the Director of Procurement Management the authority to negotiate renewals of the contract, including changes in price, for up to three additional one-year periods, and/or to extend the contract, and to execute all associated documents, with County Administration's approval, as approved in the department's annual adopted budget, if doing so is in the best interest of Lee County.

II. ITEM SUMMARY

Award contract to Thatcher Chemical of Florida, Inc. to furnish and deliver sodium bisulfite 40% aqueous solution to Lee County Utilities for use at their facilities for an initial period of one year with the option to renew for three additional one-year periods. Total expenditures for these products and services during Fiscal Year 2016-2017 were approximately \$42,790.15. This product is used as a dechlorination agent at the Fiesta Village Wastewater Treatment Plant.

III. BACKGROUND AND IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

A) Board Action and Other History

Procurement Management obtained proposals on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners for the project known as Invitation to Bid No. B180243RJD, Annual – Sodium Bisulfite 40% Aqueous Solution. On the bidding deadline of June 8, 2018, Procurement Management received two submittals. After conducting an analysis on the bid submissions, staff recommends making an award to Thatcher Chemical of Florida, Inc. as the low bidder meeting all specification requirements.

These products are budgeted annually within the Lee County Utilities operation budget. This product is used as a dechlorination agent at the Fiesta Village Wastewater plant. Expenditures for these services totaled approximately \$42,790.15 during Fiscal Year 2016-2017. Compared to the previous contract pricing, there is a price decrease of \$0.6849 per gallon.

Item Summary:

Approve the submission of the FY 2019 State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Transit Service Development Grant in the amount of \$998,573 for operating assistance for the seasonal Fort Myers Beach Tram service. Annually, FDOT awards funding under the State Transit Service Development Grant Program to projects which improve transit system efficiency, expand ridership and increase revenue. The period of service is from October 2019 to September 2022. The grant program requires a local match of the equal amount of \$998,573 which will be budgeted in FY 19/20 Transit operating budget.
