3. ARTICLE REVISION

The following article and associated clauses are hereto added to the Special Conditions of the project as found beginning on page 17:

4. LANE CLOSURE RESTRICTIONS

4.1 NO LANE CLOSURE SHALL OCCUR UNLESS ALL VIABLE ALTERNATIVES HAVE BEEN EXPLORED AND REASONS FOR THE CLOSURE ARE WARRANTED, JUSTIFIED AND DOCUMENTED. LANE

CLOSURES MUST BE APPROVED IN ADVANCE BY THE COUNTY, WHEN ABOVE CONDITIONS ARE MET.

- 4.2 No lane(s) may be closed between 6:00 am and 9:00 am or between 4:00 pm and 7:00 pm.**
- 4.3 The Contractor shall limit the area of milling operations to no more than the area that can be resurfaced with asphalt base course S-1 structural course within the same day or night operation.**
- 4.4 All lane closure requests must include consideration for special events such as major community events, sporting events and concerts.**
- 4.5 Contractors must provide notification to law enforcement agencies, local fire departments and emergency medical services for lane closures in excess of two (2) hours in duration.**
- 4.6 A MINIMUM OF ONE WEEK ADVANCE notification of any proposed lane closure exceeding two hours must be provided to the local operations center and public information office. Two (2) week notification is recommended.**
- 4.7 Work activities with lane closures will be monitored. If, in the opinion of the County, the lane closure is creating undo traffic delay and congestion, the County may suspend the work and/or modify the lane closure time.**

5.QUESTIONS/ANSWERS

1.	Has a budget or cost estimate been established for this project?
Answer	As stated in the solicitation package, Invitation to Bid, Section 14. Confidentiality, 14.3 Lee County will not reveal engineering estimates or budget amounts for a project unless required by grant funding or unless it is in the best interest of the County. Pursuant to § 337.168, F.S.: A document or electronic file revealing the official cost estimate of the department of a project is confidential and exempt from the provisions of § 119.07(1), F.S. until the Contract for the project has been executed or until the project is no longer under active consideration.
2.	Is there a start date in mind for the project?
Answer	The project is anticipated to begin within the first quarter of the new year, pending Board approval and contract execution.
