



MINIMUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Contractor must meet the minimum qualification requirements as specified in the following form to qualify for consideration of award. This form must be completed and returned with the bid submittal along with any supporting documentation were requested and/or indicated herein.

The County reserves the right, in their sole judgment, to determine to its satisfaction whether the Contractor has met the minimum qualification requirements as specified herein. The determination shall be based upon the examination of the Minimum Qualification Requirements form and associated supportive documentation (if any requested).

An affirmative determination shall be a prerequisite for award of the contract to the Contractor. A negative determination shall result in disqualification of the proposal, in which event the County shall exclude the proposal from the evaluation or consideration process and therefore deeming the Contractor ineligible for award.

CRITERIA 1 – CERTIFICATION: The Prime Contractor **must be** a Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) pre-qualified Contractor in one of the three Major Classes of Work: Drainage, Flexible Pavement or Grading.

Prime Contractor: Is your firm a Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) pre-qualified Contractor in one of the three Major Classes of Work: Drainage, Flexible Pavement or Grading?
