Answer	See attachment E-199, included in the original solicitation package.
2.	Are the bold MCC6 & MCC7 feeders on the one line picked up under another project?
Answer	All feeders out of the main switchgear must be fed from temporary cable.
3.	What are the projected start & completion dates if any?
Answer	Commencement date would be determined based on approval by the Lee
	County Board of County Commissioners. The temporary switchgear may be
	installed up to five (5) years.
4.	Will each MCC (#6 and #7) require only a single cable run (good for 1200 amps) from
	the temporary switchgear?
Answer	This should be based on the full load for each 1200 amp main.
5.	We don't need to provide all the breakers found in each MCC, correct?
Answer	Breakers in the temporary switchgear should match the one-line drawings, E-
	200 of the original solicitation package.
