No technical questions will be answered at the sites. All questions derived from these site visits should be submitted in an email to the procurement analyst assigned to this project. This is a “window of opportunity” for potential bidders to obtain access for viewing of the site. The date and time frame provided is the only allocated time slot for access. There will be no opportunity for potential bidders to stop in and request additional viewing or investigations after the date and time slot have passed. Potential bidders who attempt to do so will be turned away.

3. QUESTIONS/ANSWERS

1.	To provide an accurate quote, we will need to visit each location. Please confirm if access keys are required for any location and if so, where we can obtain a key.
Answer	See above for the scheduled site visits for the 4 secured locations. All of the other locations listed within the solicitation documents on pages 25 – 26 are accessible and are visible by the road/easement as well as viewable by Google Maps using the GPS Coordinates provided within the Solicitation.
2.	Since all sites are replacing existing stations, are ground rods already installed at each site and acceptable to use for connection to new instrumentation? Or do we need to install new?
Answer	The Vendor will need to install new grounding rods at all sites.
3.	Prior to setting poles for support structures, is the county responsible for coordinating the utility locating services for each site?
Answer	No, the Vendor will be responsible for coordinating the location of the underground utilities and following all State and Local rules and regulations regarding locating anything underground.
4.	Is a certified licensed surveyor required for completing the surveys?
Answer	Yes, a certified licensed surveyor is required for any surveying work, and it is the responsibility of the Vendor to coordinate and provided the required surveys as per the Solicitation on page 27.
