Your Library Account

The barcode on your library card is your library account number. Your PIN is usually the last four digits of your phone number and is used as your password.

To access your account, you will always need to provide your library account number and PIN.

You can access your information online at leelibrary.net/account or call (239) 485-8585 for automated account information.

You can choose to receive your account notifications by phone, email or text. Notifications are also available in Spanish. These preferences may be selected in your account online or by speaking with a staff member.

Library cards must be renewed in person every two years. You can do this at any branch.

Charges and Fees

- The overdue charge is 20¢ per day, to a maximum of \$6 for most items.
- Lost or damaged items are subject to a replacement fee.
- Materials Recovery Fee: Up to \$13

Privacy

We take privacy and confidentiality seriously.

Florida Statute 257.61 restricts access by others to your personal information such as address and phone number, and all information about your library use such as items currently checked out, requests, charges, and more.

If you want to update your information, place a hold, find out what is overdue, etc., you must provide staff with the card or card number for the library account.

We do not share, sell, rent, or report your library registration or borrowing information to anyone.

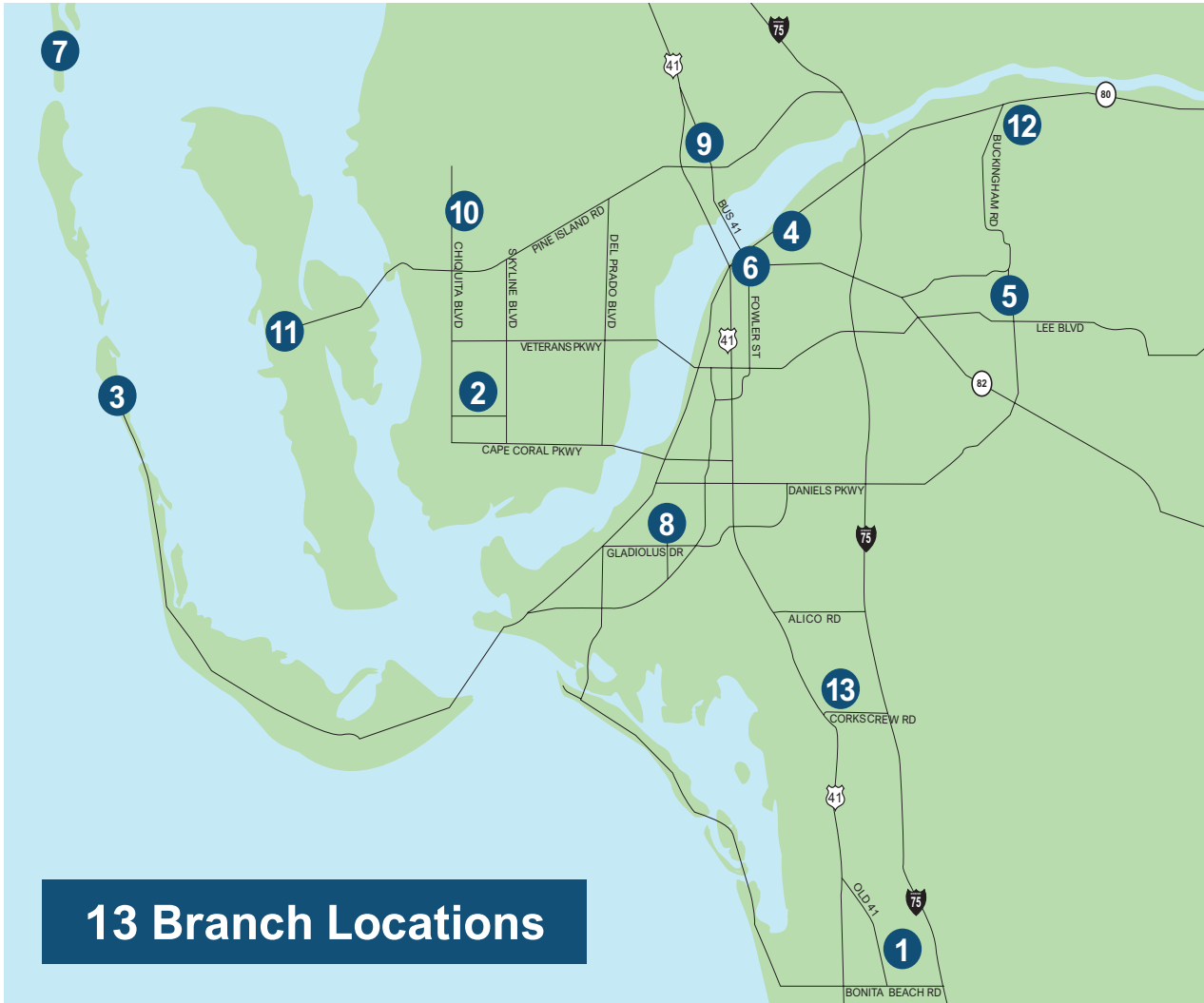
