Dear Mr. Malo:

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) has completed the review and evaluation of your modification request, received on September 19, 2023, in which you asked to revise the project specific special conditions that were included in the Department of the Army emergency permit verification letter for permit number SAJ-2002-07813(NWP-HMM), issued to Lee County BoCC, dated March 28, 2023. The project site is located at an unnamed residential canal on the west side of Old Pelican Bay Drive, Section 13, Township 46 South, Range 23 East, Fort Myers Beach, Lee County, Florida (Latitude: 26.47237°; Longitude: -81.95879°).

The proposed modification would result in the addition of the following special condition to the verification. The modification must be completed in accordance with the original construction drawings and additional special condition, which is incorporated in, and made a part of the permit:

16: Construction Completion: If you commence or are under contract to commence this activity before the date that this emergency permit expires, you will have 12 months from the expiration date to complete the activity under the present terms and conditions of this permit.


The impact of your proposal on navigation and the environment has been reviewed and found to be insignificant. The verification is hereby modified in accordance with your request. You should attach this letter to the verification letter. All other conditions of the verification letter remain in full force and effect.
