AGREEMENT FOR GENERATOR MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, & INSTALLATION SERVICES COUNTYWIDE

THIS AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made and entered into by and between Lee County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "County" and Accurate Power and Technology, Inc., a Florida corporation whose address is 15519 West US Highway 441, Suite 101A, Eustis, FL 32726, and whose federal tax identification number is 20-2663060, hereinafter referred to as "Vendor."

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the County intends to purchase preventative maintenance, repair, and installation services, to include emergency service, for Lee County's generators from the Vendor in connection with "Generator Maintenance, Repair, & Installation Services Countywide" (the "Purchase"); and,

WHEREAS, the County issued Solicitation No. B240559DJN on January 17, 2025 (the "Solicitation"); and,

WHEREAS, the County evaluated the responses received and found the Vendor qualified to provide the necessary products and services; and,

WHEREAS, the County posted a Notice of Intended Decision on March 21, 2025; and,

WHEREAS, the Vendor has reviewed the products and services to be supplied pursuant to this Agreement and is qualified, willing and able to provide all such products and services in accordance with its terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, the County and the Vendor, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, do agree as follows:

I. PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

The Vendor agrees to diligently provide all products and services for the Purchase, a more specific description of the Project Scope of Services is set forth in the Scope of Work and Specifications Section, of B240559DJN, a photocopy of said section(s) being attached hereto and incorporated by reference as Exhibit A. Vendor shall comply strictly with all of the terms and conditions of Solicitation No. B240559DJN, as modified by its addendum, copies of which are on file with the County's Department of Procurement Management and are deemed incorporated into this Agreement.

II. TERM AND DELIVERY

- A. This Agreement shall commence immediately upon the effective date and shall continue through one (1), three (3) year period. Upon mutual written agreement of both parties, the parties may renew the Agreement, in whole or in part, for a renewal term or terms not to exceed the term of two (2) years. The increments of renewal shall be at the sole discretion of the County as deemed in its best interest. The effective date shall be the date the Lee County Board of County Commissioners awarded the Solicitation to the Vendor.
- B. A purchase order must be issued by the County before commencement of any work or purchase of any goods related to this Agreement.

III. COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT

- A. The County shall pay the Vendor in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement for providing all products and services as set forth in Exhibit A, and further described in Exhibit C, Fee Schedule, attached hereto and incorporated herein. Said total amount to be all inclusive of costs necessary to provide all products and services as outlined in this Agreement, and as supported by the Vendor's submittal in response to the Solicitation, a copy of which is on file with the County's Department of Procurement Management and is deemed incorporated into this Agreement.
- B. Notwithstanding the preceding, Vendor shall not make any deliveries or perform any services under this Agreement until receipt of written authorization from the County. Vendor acknowledges and agrees that no minimum order or amount of product or service is guaranteed under this Agreement and County may elect to request no products or services. If the County authorizes delivery of products or performance of services, the County reserves the right to amend, reduce, or cancel the authorization in its sole discretion.
- C. All funds for payment by the County under this Agreement are subject to the availability of an annual appropriation for this purpose by the County. In the event of non-appropriation of funds by the County for the services provided under this Agreement, the County will terminate the contract, without termination charge or other liability, on the last day of the then current fiscal year or when the appropriation made for the then-current year for the services covered by this Agreement is spent, whichever event occurs first. If at any time funds are not appropriated for the continuance of this Agreement, cancellation shall be accepted by the Vendor on thirty (30) days' prior written notice, but failure to give such notice shall be of no effect and the County shall not be obligated under this Agreement beyond the date of termination.

IV. METHOD OF PAYMENT

- A. The County shall pay the Vendor in accordance with the Local Government Prompt Payment Act, Section 218.70, Florida Statutes, upon receipt of the Vendor's invoice and written approval of same by the County indicating that the products and services have been provided in conformity with this Agreement.
- B. The Vendor shall submit an invoice for payment to the County on a monthly basis for those specific products and services as described in Exhibit A (and the corresponding fees as described in Exhibit C) that were provided during that invoicing period.
- C. For partial shipments or deliveries, progress payments shall be paid monthly in proportion to the percentage of products and services delivered on those specific line items as approved in writing by the County.

V. ADDITIONAL PURCHASES

- A. No changes to this Agreement or the performance contemplated hereunder shall be made unless the same are in writing and signed by both the Vendor and the County.
- B. If the County requires the Vendor to perform additional services or provide additional product(s) related to this Agreement, then the Vendor shall be entitled to additional compensation based on the Fee Schedule as amended to the extent necessary to accommodate such additional work or product(s). The additional compensation shall be agreed upon before commencement of any additional services or provision of additional product(s) and shall be incorporated into this Agreement by written amendment. The County shall not pay for any additional service, work performed or product provided before a written amendment to this Agreement.

Notwithstanding the preceding, in the event additional services are required as a result of error, omission or negligence of the Vendor, the Vendor shall not be entitled to additional compensation.

VI. LIABILITY OF VENDOR

- A. The Vendor shall save, defend, indemnify and hold harmless the County from and against any and all claims, actions, damages, fees, fines, penalties, defense costs, suits or liabilities which may arise out of any act, neglect, error, omission or default of the Vendor arising out of or in any way connected with the Vendor or subcontractor's performance or failure to perform under the terms of this Agreement.
- B. This section shall survive the termination or expiration of this Agreement.

VII. VENDOR'S INSURANCE

- A. Vendor shall procure and maintain insurance as specified in Exhibit D Insurance Requirements, attached hereto and made a part of this Agreement.
- B. Vendor shall, on a primary basis and at its sole expense, maintain in full force and effect, at all times during the life of this Agreement, insurance coverage (including endorsements) and limits as described in Exhibit D. These requirements, as well as the County's review or acceptance of insurance maintained by Vendor, are not intended to and shall not in any manner limit or qualify the liabilities or obligations assumed by Vendor under this Agreement. Insurance carriers providing coverage required herein must be licensed to conduct business in the State of Florida and must possess a current A.M. Best's Financial Strength Rating of "B or better." No changes are to be made to these specifications without prior written specific approval by County Risk Management. To the extent multiple insurance coverages and/or County's self-insured retention may apply, any and all insurance coverage purchased by Vendor and its subcontractors identifying the County as an additional named insured shall be primary.

VIII. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE VENDOR

- A. The Vendor shall be responsible for the quality and functionality of all products supplied and services performed by or at the behest of the Vendor under this Agreement. The Vendor shall, without additional compensation, correct any errors or deficiencies in its products, or if directed by County, supply a comparable replacement product or service.
- B. The Vendor warrants that it has not employed or retained any company or person (other than a bona fide employee working solely for the Vendor), to solicit or secure this Agreement and that it has not paid or agreed to pay any person, company, corporation, individual, or firm other than a bona fide employee working solely for the Vendor, any fee, commission, percentage, gift, or any other consideration, contingent upon or resulting from the award of this Agreement.
- C. The Vendor shall comply with all federal, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances applicable to the work or payment for work thereof, and shall not discriminate on the grounds of race, color, religion, sex, or national origin in the performance of work under this Agreement.
- D. Vendor specifically acknowledges its obligations to comply with Section 119.0701, Florida Statutes, with regard to public records, and shall:

- 1) keep and maintain public records that ordinarily and necessarily would be required by the County in order to perform the services required under this Agreement;
- 2) upon request from the County, provide the County with a copy of the requested records or allow the records to be inspected or copied within a reasonable time at a cost that does not exceed the cost provided in Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, or as otherwise provided by law;
- 3) ensure that public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements are not disclosed, except as authorized by law; and
- 4) meet all requirements for retaining public records and transfer, at no cost to the County, all public records in possession of Vendor upon termination of this Agreement and destroy any duplicate public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements. All records stored electronically must be provided to the County in a format that is compatible with the information technology system of the County.

- E. The Vendor is, and shall be, in the performance of all work, services and activities under this Agreement, an independent contractor. Vendor is not an employee, agent or servant of the County and shall not represent itself as such. All persons engaged in any work or services performed pursuant to this Agreement shall at all times, and in all places, be subject to the Vendor's sole direction, supervision and control. The Vendor shall exercise control over the means and manner in which it and its employees perform the work, and in all respects the Vendor's relationship and the relationship of its employees to the County shall be that of an independent contractor and not as employees of the County. The Vendor shall be solely responsible for providing benefits and insurance to its employees.
- F. The Vendor shall comply with the Vendor Background Screening Affidavit attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit E.

IX. OWNERSHIP OF PRODUCTS

It is understood and agreed that all products provided under this Agreement shall become the property of the County upon acceptance by the County.

X. TIMELY DELIVERY OF PRODUCTS AND PERFORMANCE OF SERVICES

- A. The Vendor shall ensure that all of its staff, contractors and suppliers involved in the production or delivery of the products are fully qualified and capable to perform their assigned tasks.
- B. The personnel assigned by the Vendor to perform the services pursuant to this Agreement shall comply with the terms set forth in this Agreement. If the services provided require use of specific key personnel, the personnel shall be agreed to by the County and Vendor. If the Vendor's key personnel have been predetermined and approved, through the Solicitation process or otherwise, any subsequent change or substitution to the personnel must receive the County's written approval before said changes or substitution can become effective.
- C. The Vendor specifically agrees that all products shall be delivered within the time limits as set forth in this Agreement, subject only to delays caused by force majeure, or as otherwise defined herein. "Force majeure" shall be deemed to be any unforeseeable and unavoidable cause affecting the performance of this Agreement arising from or attributable to acts, events, omissions or accidents beyond the control of the parties.

XI. COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida. Vendor shall promptly comply with all applicable federal, state, county and municipal laws, ordinances, regulations, and rules relating to the services to be performed hereunder and in effect at the time of performance. Vendor shall conduct no activity or provide any service that is unlawful or offensive.

XII. CONTRACT TERMINATION

- A. MATERIAL BREACH A Vendor may be Terminated for Cause by the County, at the sole discretion of the Procurement Management Director, for failing to perform a contractual requirement or for a material breach of any term or condition. A material breach of a term or condition of the Agreement may include but is not limited to: 1. Vendor failure to perform services or deliver materials, supplies, or equipment by the date required or by an alternate date as mutually agreed in a written amendment to the Agreement; 2. Vendor failure to carry out any warranty or fails to perform or comply with any mandatory provision of the Agreement; 3. Vendor becomes insolvent or in an unsound financial condition so as to endanger performance hereunder; 4. Vendor becomes the subject of any proceeding

under any law relating to bankruptcy, insolvency or reorganization, or relief from creditors and/or debtors that endangers the Vendor's proper performance hereunder; 5. Appointment of any receiver, trustee, or similar official for Vendor or any of the Vendor's property and such appointment endangers the Vendor's proper performance hereunder; 6. A determination that the Vendor is in violation of federal, state, or local laws or regulations and that such determination renders the Vendor unable to perform any aspect of the Agreement.

- B. **OPPORTUNITY TO CURE** In the event that Vendor fails to perform a contractual requirement or materially breaches any term or condition, the County may issue a written cure notice. The Vendor may have a period of time in which to cure. The County is not required to allow the Vendor to cure defects if the opportunity for cure is not feasible as, determined solely within the discretion of the County. Time allowed for cure shall not diminish or eliminate Vendor's liability for damages, or otherwise affect any other remedies available against Vendor under the Agreement or by law. If the breach remains after Vendor has been provided the opportunity to cure, the County may do any one or more of the following: 1. Exercise any remedy provided by law; 2. Terminate this Agreement and any related contracts or portions thereof; 3. Procure replacements and impose damages as set forth elsewhere in this Agreement, if applicable; 4. Impose actual or liquidated damages; 5. Suspend or bar Vendor from receiving future solicitations or other opportunities; 6. Require Vendor to reimburse the County for any loss or additional expense incurred as a result of default or failure to satisfactorily perform the terms of the Agreement.
- C. **TERMINATION FOR CAUSE** In the event the Procurement Management Director, in his/her sole discretion, determines that the Vendor has failed to comply with the conditions of this Agreement in a timely manner or is in material breach, the Procurement Management Director has the right to terminate this Agreement, in part or in whole. If corrective action is deemed acceptable by the County, the Procurement Management Director shall notify the Vendor in writing of the need to take corrective action and the date in which the corrective action must be completed. If corrective action is not completed as specified by the Procurement Management Director, or if such corrective action is deemed by the County to be insufficient, the Agreement may be terminated. The County reserves the right to withhold further payments, or prohibit the Vendor from incurring additional obligations of funds during investigation of the alleged breach and pending corrective action by the Vendor or a decision by the County to terminate the Agreement. In the event of termination, the County shall have the right to procure any replacement materials, supplies, services and/or equipment that are the subject of this Agreement on the open market. In addition, the Vendor shall be liable for damages as authorized by law including, but not limited to, any price difference between the original Agreement and the replacement or cover contract and all administrative costs directly related to the replacement contract, e.g., cost of the competitive bidding, mailing,

advertising and staff time. If it is determined that: (1) the Vendor was not in material breach; or (2) failure to perform was outside of Vendor's or its subcontractor's control, fault or negligence, the termination shall be deemed to be a "Termination for Convenience." The rights and remedies of the County provided in this Agreement are not exclusive and are in addition to any other rights and remedies provided by law.

- D. **TERMINATION FOR CONVENIENCE** Except as otherwise provided in this Agreement, the County, at the sole discretion of the Procurement Management Director, may terminate this Agreement, in whole or in part by giving thirty (30) calendar days written notice beginning on the second day after mailing to the Vendor. If this Agreement is so terminated, the County shall be liable only for payment required under this Agreement for properly authorized services rendered, or materials, supplies and/or equipment delivered to and accepted by the County prior to the effective date of Agreement termination. The County shall have no other obligation whatsoever to the Vendor for such termination.
- E. The County reserves the right to require Vendor to repay amounts previously paid by the County to the Vendor due to untimely completion of services, inadequate completion of services, or lack of completion of services and the Vendor shall comply with such demand within 30 days.
- F. The County's rights under this Agreement shall survive the termination or expiration of this Agreement and are not waived by final payment or acceptance and are in addition to the Vendor's obligations under this Agreement.

XIII. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- A. In the event of a dispute or claim arising out of this Agreement, the parties agree first to try in good faith to settle the dispute by direct discussion. If this is unsuccessful, the parties may enter into mediation in Lee County, Florida, with the parties sharing equally in the cost of such mediation.
- B. In the event mediation, if attempted, is unsuccessful in resolving a dispute, the parties may proceed to litigation as set forth below.
- C. Any dispute, action or proceeding arising out of or related to this Agreement will be exclusively commenced in the state courts of Lee County, Florida, or where proper subject matter jurisdiction exists, in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida. Each party irrevocably submits and waives any objections to the exclusive personal jurisdiction and venue of such courts, including any objection based on forum non conveniens.
- D. This Agreement and the rights and obligations of the parties shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida without regard to its conflict of laws principles.

- E. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, the Vendor shall be required to continue all obligations under this Agreement during the pendency of a claim or dispute including, but not limited to, actual periods of mediation or judicial proceedings.

XIV. STOP WORK ORDER

The County may, at any time, by written order to the Vendor, require the Vendor to stop all or any part of the work called for by this Agreement. Any order shall be identified specifically as a stop work order issued pursuant to this clause. This order shall be effective as of the date the order is delivered to the Vendor. Upon receipt of such an order, the Vendor shall immediately comply with its terms and take all reasonable steps to minimize the incurrence of costs allocable to the work covered by the order during the period of work stoppage. The Vendor shall not resume work unless specifically so directed in writing by the County. The County may take one of the following actions:

1. Cancel the stop work order; or
2. Terminate the work covered by the order; or
3. Terminate the Agreement in accordance with provisions contained in Section XII.

In the event the County does not direct the Vendor to resume work, the stop work order may be converted into a notice of termination for convenience pursuant to Section XII. The notice period for such termination shall be deemed to commence on the date of issuance of the stop work order. In the event the County does not direct the Vendor to resume work within ninety (90) days, the Vendor may terminate this Agreement.

XV. VENDOR WARRANTY

- A. All products provided under this Agreement shall be new (unless specifically identified otherwise in Exhibit C) and of the most suitable grade for the purpose intended.
- B. If any product delivered does not meet performance representations or other quality assurance representations as published by manufacturers, producers or distributors of the products or the specifications listed in this Agreement, the Vendor shall pick up the product from the County at no expense to the County. The County reserves the right to reject any or all materials if, in its judgment, the item reflects unsatisfactory workmanship or manufacturing or shipping damage. In such case, the Vendor shall refund to the County any money which has been paid for same.

- C. Vendor shall secure from the applicable third-party manufacturers, and assign and pass through to the County, at no additional cost to the County, such warranties as may be available with respect to the equipment, parts and systems provided through the Purchase.
- D. For 12 month(s) from the date of County's receipt of products provided hereunder, Vendor warrants that the products under normal use and service will be free from material defects in materials and workmanship. In the event Vendor's standard product warranty is for a period of time longer than 12 month(s), this warranty shall be extended to that longer duration.

XVI. MISCELLANEOUS

- A. This Agreement constitutes the sole and complete understanding between the parties and supersedes all other contracts between them, whether oral or written, with respect to the subject matter. No amendment, change or addendum to this Agreement is enforceable unless agreed to in writing by both parties and incorporated into this Agreement.
- B. The provisions of this Agreement shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the respective successors and assignees of the parties hereto. A party to this Agreement shall not sell, transfer, assign, license, franchise, restructure, alter, or change its corporate structure or otherwise part with possession or mortgage, charge or encumber any right or obligation under this Agreement without the proposed assignee and/or party restructuring, altering or changing its corporate structure agreeing in writing with the non-assigning party to observe and perform the terms, conditions and restrictions on the part of the assigning party to this Agreement, whether express or implied, as if the proposed assignee and/or party restructuring, altering or changing its corporate structure was an original contracting party to this Agreement. Notwithstanding the foregoing provision, the Vendor may assign its rights if given written authorization by the County and claims for the money due or to become due to the Vendor from the County under this Agreement may be assigned to a financial institution or to a trustee in bankruptcy without such approval from the County. Notice of any such transfer or assignment due to bankruptcy shall be promptly given to the County.
- C. The exercise by either party of any rights or remedies provided herein shall not constitute a waiver of any other rights or remedies available under this Agreement or any applicable law.
- D. The failure of the County to enforce one or more of the provisions of the Agreement shall not be construed to be and shall not be a waiver of any such provision or provisions or of its right thereafter to enforce each and every such provision.

- E. The parties covenant and agree that each is duly authorized to enter into and perform this Agreement and those executing this Agreement have all requisite power and authority to bind the parties.
- F. Neither the County's review, approval or acceptance of, nor payment for, the products and services required under this Agreement shall be construed to operate as a waiver of any rights under this Agreement or of any cause of action arising out of the performance of this Agreement.
- G. If the Vendor is comprised of more than one legal entity, each entity shall be jointly and severally liable hereunder.
- H. When any period of time is referred to by days herein, it shall be computed to exclude the first day and include the last day of such period. When the period of time is fewer than three (3) days, it shall mean business days as defined by Lee County. If the period of time is greater than three (3) days, then it shall mean calendar days. For any period of time greater than seven (7) days, where the deadline falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or Lee County recognized holiday, the deadline will then fall to the next Monday or non-Lee County recognized holiday.
- I. Any notices of default or termination shall be sufficient if sent by the parties via email, United States certified mail, postage paid, or via a nationally recognized delivery service, to the addresses listed below:

- K. Paragraph headings are for the convenience of the parties and for reference purposes only and shall be given no legal effect.
- L. Each individual signing this Agreement directly and expressly warrants that he/she has been given and has received and accepted authority to sign and execute the Agreement on behalf of the party for whom it is indicated he/she has signed, and further has been expressly given and received and accepted authority to enter into a binding agreement on behalf of such party with respect to the matters contained herein and as stated herein.

M. In the event of conflicts or inconsistencies, the documents shall be given precedence in the following order:

1. Agreement
2. County's Purchase Order
3. Solicitation
4. Vendor's Submittal in Response to the Solicitation

EXHIBIT A

SCOPE OF WORK AND SPECIFICATIONS

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SCOPE OF WORK AND SPECIFICATIONS

1. GENERAL SCOPE OF WORK

- 1.1. The Lee County Board of County Commissioners seeks to contract with a qualified Primary and Secondary Vendor to provide preventative maintenance, repair, and installation services, to include emergency service, for Lee County's generators during normal working hours, after hours, and on standby during emergencies on an as needed basis as determined by Lee County Departments.
- 1.2. The Vendor shall provide all personnel, equipment, tools, supervision, and other items and services necessary to perform preventative maintenance, repairs, installation, and troubleshooting, to ensure generators are fully functional and properly maintained. Preventative maintenance and repair services will be on an as needed basis as determined by the requesting Lee County Departments. Preventative maintenance and repairs shall comply with NFPA 70B, NFPA 110, and the manufacturer specifications.

2. ACCESS TO COUNTY PROPERTY AND GENERATORS

- 2.1. All scheduled tests and inspections shall be pre-determined and coordinated between the Vendor and the County prior to work being performed. A schedule of services for the contract year shall be developed by the Vendor and will be reviewed and approved by the County. Hours are subject to change based on the needs of the County and the departments.
- 2.2. Regular on-site work shall be conducted during normal business hours Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding weekends and County recognized holidays.

2.2.1. The following is a list of holidays that are observed by Lee County:

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2.3. Specific buildings will require work to be performed after hours or on the weekends. They have been identified as, but are not limited to the following:

2.3.1. Admin /Old Courthouse (2201 Second Street, Fort Myers, FL 33901)

2.3.2. Admin East (2115 Second St, Fort Myers, FL 33901)

2.3.3. Justice Center Complex (1700 Monroe St. Fort Myers, FL 33901)

2.3.4. Justice Center Annex (2000 Main St. Ft. Myers, FL. 33901)

2.4. This agreement is not for any specific location(s). The user department may require services at any location deemed necessary by the County.

3. **SPECIFICATIONS**

3.1. Vendor shall have the ability to provide services to the assets owned by the County.

3.1.1. The County reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to add or remove generators from the scope of work, adjust the frequency of service cycles, or terminate the agreement if deemed in the County's best interest. For any additional services required for new generators, the County and the Vendor may negotiate a mutually agreeable price.

3.2. **Repairs**

3.2.1. The Vendor shall provide a separate quote for individual repairs identified during the maintenance and inspection of generators. Repairs are categorized as emergency or non-emergency depending on the severity and urgency determined by the County representative.

3.2.2. If proprietary software cannot be accessed by the vendor for repairs or service, the County has the right to contact the generator or transfer switch manufacturer directly to gain access or to coordinate repairs with the manufacturer.

3.2.3. **Emergency Repair Services**

3.2.3.1. The Vendor shall have a 24-hour point of contact and the capability to respond to the sites within two hours once contact is made. An emergency condition shall be considered to exist when any failed system hardware or software prevents, or threatens to prevent, the operation of the generator or switchgear from fulfilling its intended purpose. It will be at the sole discretion of the County to determine if the situation is an emergency or not.

3.2.3.2. Emergency repair service requests may include pre-storm preparations and post-storm recovery services.

3.2.4. **Non-Emergency Repair Services**

3.2.4.1. The Vendor shall respond within two (2) business days of receiving a request for service. The Vendor shall provide written "Not to Exceed" estimates on all non-emergency repair services. This estimate shall include the estimated number of hours, hourly rate, material cost, and completion date. It shall be the Vendor's responsibility to ensure they have all information to prepare accurate estimates.

3.2.4.2. The County reserves the right to request additional estimates from other vendors outside of the agreement, if the County believes estimates from all Vendors holding a contract are unbalanced or unreasonable.

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3.3. Dress Code

3.3.1. The Vendor's employees shall wear uniforms bearing the company name while on County property and shall carry identification confirming that they are employees of the company.

3.3.2. The Vendor's vehicles shall bear the company name/logo while on County property.

3.4. Preventative Maintenance and Inspections (total of four per year)

3.4.1. Regular Service is performed three times per year as stand-alone service and once per year in conjunction with the Full Service performed annually, as defined below.

3.4.2. The Vendor shall stock air filters, fuel filters, oil filters, belts, and fluids such as oil and coolant.

3.4.2.1. Minimum standards for oil:

3.4.3. Regular Service (three per year)

3.4.3.1. Cooling System – operating temperature, hoses, radiator, drive belts, coolant heater, coolant level, water pump, fan, coolant concentration.

3.4.3.2. Fuel System – hoses, day tank and primary tank condition, gauge operation, level in inches or gallons, high level alarm, rupture basin alarm, fuel transfer pump, governor, water separator (drain).

3.4.3.3. Exhaust (Intake) – piping, rain cap, ambient temperature, crankcase breather, turbochargers, air cleaners, air filters.

3.4.3.4. Lubrication – oil level, oil pressure, check for leaks, hydraulic governor.

3.4.3.5. General condition – engine room cleanliness, controller position, engine mounts, hour meter, enclosure, logbook (record service type, date, and hours).

3.4.3.6. Electrical system – battery fluid, battery alternator, battery voltage drop, battery charger, battery voltage, frequency in HZ, breaker, load as amps/phase, visual on wiring, test safeties.

3.4.3.7. Transfer switch – adjust timers, check lamps and annunciator, test transfer switch when applicable, run unit under load when applicable.

3.4.4. Full Service (one per year)

3.4.4.1. To include all “Regular Service” activities in addition to the following:

3.4.4.2. Change engine oil and oil filters.

3.4.4.3. Change fuel filters.

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3.4.4.4. Change water filters if applicable.

3.4.4.5. Lubricate bearings, gears, or belt drives.

3.4.5. Engine Side - Coolant (every other year)

3.4.5.1. Coolant DCA filters changed, coolant replaced if necessary (visual inspection).

3.4.6. Tier 4 portables

3.4.6.1. DEF - Quarterly drain and refill.

3.5. Electrical Safety Plan

3.5.1. The Vendor shall maintain an electrical safety plan to support preventative maintenance that requires energized electrical testing, tasks, and procedures. The electrical safety plan shall comply with NFPA 70E and be provided to the County after award.

3.6. Warranty

3.6.1. All materials and/or services furnished under this Agreement are warranted by the Vendor to be free from defects and fit for the intended use. At a minimum, the Vendor(s) shall provide warranties on all work as follows:

3.6.1.1. Twelve (12) months on repairs, labor, and materials.

3.6.1.2. Manufacturer's warranty on any new equipment/parts.

3.7. Security Access Requirements

3.7.1. Security clearance is required for access to certain generators throughout the County. Employees, including Supervisors and Technicians, shall obtain a security clearance through the LCSO (Lee County Sheriff's Office) and the Clerk of Court Office. Employees shall undergo a fingerprint based NCIC background check and must be able to obtain a security clearance from the Lee County Sheriff's Office. Also, Vendor's employees shall be required to undergo a fingerprint-based criminal background check in addition to the standard consumer report-based background check that is required for all conditional offers of employment.

3.7.2. Must have security clearance for employees within one month after contract award.

3.7.3. Online Level 1 Security Awareness Training and security clearance renewal will be required annually.

3.8. Load Banking

3.8.1. Load banking shall be on an as needed basis. Any load banking shall be at the direction of County Personnel.

3.8.2. All tests, inspections and repairs shall be performed in accordance with the manufacturer Load Bank specifications.

3.9. Installations

3.9.1. The Vendor shall remove and replace existing generators with a new generator provided by the County. The Vendor shall install the new generator, control cables and automatic transfer switches per the generator manufacturer requirements, and ensure the generator is operational. The Vendor shall provide

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a one-year installation warranty. Any permits that are required, shall be submitted by the Vendor, and will be paid by the County.

3.10.Documentation

- 3.10.1. The Vendor's generator technician shall fill out the applicable maintenance checklist (service report) in its entirety at each visit, and log the date, hours, and service performed in the generator logbook if available on site. All measured parameters shall be recorded on the checklist. Any additional repairs needed shall be recorded in the comments section of the checklist and reported via email to the designated County contact for follow up. A copy of the checklists is provided in Attachment 1 - 3.

3.11.Invoicing

- 3.11.1. Vendor shall submit separate invoices to each department served on a monthly basis. Invoices shall include the following information:

- 3.11.1.1. County work order, purchase order number or contract number.
- 3.11.1.2. Hourly rate: hourly rates cannot exceed their individual position titles per the fee schedule within the executed agreement.
- 3.11.1.3. Name and address of location/facility where the work was performed.
- 3.11.1.4. Description of work performed and when work started and was completed. Vendor shall provide a copy of all inspection checklists with appropriate test results; e.g. generator tests.
- 3.11.1.5. Service Charge Fee (if applicable).
- 3.11.1.6. Must identify which equipment was serviced.
- 3.11.1.7. All replacement and new parts shall be identified on the invoice with the part number, quantity, and its actual cost. Vendor's percentage markup shall be included on a separate line item. Total sum of actual cost and vendor's percentage markup shall be displayed on the invoice. Proof of the cost for parts shall be submitted with the invoice. All part numbers shall be placed within the invoice.
- 3.11.1.8. Materials that the Vendor has in stock and not specifically purchased for a County project do not need to have back-up attached unless the County deems the cost of the item to be substantial. When the County so deems the cost to be substantial, the County will request the back-up for the item in question. The Project Manager may approve the cost of all material not specifically purchased for the County. The agreed upon cost shall be inclusive of any sales taxes paid for by the vendor.

3.12.Labor Rates

- 3.12.1. The hourly labor rates shall include all costs associated with the performance of the services specified, except parts cost. Hourly rate shall include direct labor, equipment use, mileage, incidental parts and materials, tools, overhead supervision, insurance, and all other associated costs.
- 3.12.2. Incidental replacement parts and materials are defined as those materials used in the cost of doing everyday business. This includes but not limited to, nuts, bolts, screws, lubricants, fuel, etc.
- 3.12.3. Labor hours paid shall be only productive hours at the job site.

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3.13. Service Charge Fee (Outside Lee County and Boca Grande)

- 3.13.1. Service charge shall be defined as a one (1) time trip charge that shall include all mileage to and from location(s) being serviced. Fee shall include any drive time, fuel, mileage, and tolls. The Service Charge Fee shall only apply to Boca Grande and locations outside Lee County.
- 3.13.2. In the event of multiple locations being serviced on the same day, only one (1) service charge shall be charged for that day.

4. JOB DESCRIPTIONS

4.1. **Field Service Technician** is responsible for maintaining, troubleshooting, and repairing generator systems. Their duties typically include:

- 4.1.1. **Maintenance:** Performing routine maintenance tasks such as inspecting, testing, and cleaning generators to ensure they operate efficiently and reliably. This may involve checking fluid levels, changing filters, and testing electrical components.
- 4.1.2. **Repair:** Conduct repairs on generators as needed, which may involve replacing faulty parts, repairing wiring, or addressing any other issues identified during troubleshooting.

- 4.2.3. **Testing:** Conducting load bank testing to verify the performance and capacity of generator systems under simulated operating conditions.
- 4.2.4. **Documentation:** Maintaining detailed records of all maintenance, repairs, and inspections performed on generator systems to ensure compliance with regulations and provide a service history for each unit.
- 4.2.5. **Customer Service:** Interacting with clients to address any questions or concerns they may have about their generator systems and providing recommendations for optimizing performance or addressing issues.

4.3. **Field Supervisor** is typically responsible for overseeing electrical generator installation, maintenance, and repair. Their duties may include:

- 4.3.1. **Supervising Installation:** They ensure that generators are installed correctly according to specifications and safety standards. This involves coordinating with installation teams, inspecting work, and troubleshooting any issues arising during installation.

- 4.3.5. **Documentation and Reporting:** Maintaining detailed, accurate records of maintenance activities, repairs, and inspections. Documenting all work performed and generating reports for the customer.

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SPECIAL CONDITIONS

These are conditions that are in relation to this solicitation only and have not been included in the County's standard Terms and Conditions or the Scope of Work.

1. TERM

- 1.1. The Vendor shall be responsible for furnishing and delivering to the Lee County requesting Department(s) the commodity or services on an "as needed basis" for one (1) three-year (3) period. Upon mutual written agreement of both parties, the parties may renew the Agreement, in whole or in part, for a renewal term or terms not to exceed the term of two (2) years. The increments of renewal shall be at the sole discretion of the County as deemed in its best interest.

2. BASIS OF AWARD

- 2.1. The basis of award shall be determined by the lowest Project Total Bid of the most responsive, responsible, and qualified Vendor meeting all bid specifications.
- 2.2. The County intends to award contracts for a Primary and Secondary Vendor.
- 2.3. Vendor is not required to bid line item 10 for new equipment purchases to be considered for award.
- 2.4. Vendor is required to bid on all line items to be considered for award.
- 2.5. Material Markup
 - 2.5.1. The Percentage markup for repair components and new equipment shall be added to the Vendor-incurred costs for such items. The County reserves the right at any point during the term of the Agreement, inclusive of any renewals, to request supporting documentation of Vendor invoiced amounts of material markup items. Line item 9 and 204 is capped at 15%. Vendors shall not alter or change the percentage mark-up or may be deemed non-responsive.

3. LOCAL PREFERENCE

- 3.1. The Lee County Local Vendor Preference shall be included as part of the award process for this project. As such, Lee County at its sole discretion may choose to award a preference to any qualified Local Vendor.

4. MASTER AGREEMENT NOTICE

- 4.1. This is a "Master" agreement, which is not for any specific project. Work to be performed under this agreement will be authorized, scheduled, funded, and accounted for by the issuance of Purchase Order, by the County.
- 4.2. A Purchase Order shall be issued by the County before commencement of any work related to this Agreement. Vendor acknowledges and agrees that no minimum order or amount of work is guaranteed under this Agreement and no minimum charge shall be applied to any work given to the Vendor by County.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS



Lee County Insurance Requirements

Minimum Insurance Requirements: *Risk Management in no way represents that the insurance required is sufficient or adequate to protect the vendors' interest or liabilities. The following are the required minimums the vendor must maintain throughout the duration of this contract. The County reserves the right to request additional documentation regarding insurance provided*

- a. **Commercial General Liability** - Coverage shall apply to premises and/or operations, products and completed operations, independent contractors, contractual liability exposures with minimum limits of:
- \$1,000,000 per occurrence
 - \$2,000,000 general aggregate
 - \$1,000,000 products and completed operations
 - \$1,000,000 personal and advertising injury
- b. **Business Auto Liability** - The following Automobile Liability will be required and coverage shall apply to all owned, hired and non-owned vehicles use with minimum limits of:
- \$1,000,000 combined single limit (CSL); or
 - \$500,000 bodily injury per person
 - \$1,000,000 bodily injury per accident
 - \$500,000 property damage per accident
- c. **Workers' Compensation** - Statutory benefits as defined by FS 440 encompassing all operations contemplated by this contract or agreement to apply to all owners, officers, and employees regardless of the number of employees. Workers Compensation exemptions may be accepted with written proof of the State of Florida's approval of such exemption. Employers' liability will have minimum limits of:
- \$500,000 per accident
 - \$500,000 disease limit
 - \$500,000 disease – policy limit

****The required minimum limit of liability shown in a. and b. may be provided in the form of "Excess Insurance" or "Commercial Umbrella Policies." In which case, a "Following Form Endorsement" will be required on the "Excess Insurance Policy" or "Commercial Umbrella Policy."***



Lee County Insurance Requirements

Verification of Coverage:

1. Coverage shall be in place prior to the commencement of any work and throughout the duration of the contract. A certificate of insurance will be provided to the Risk Manager for review and approval. The certificate shall provide for the following:

Florida Statutes Chapter 435 governs required background screenings for any employees, contractors, subcontractors, or agents of the Vendor who will have contact with any vulnerable person, as defined by statute, or who otherwise are required to undergo a Level 1 or Level 2 background screening in accordance with Florida law.

Under penalty of perjury, I declare that I have read and understand the requirements stated above, and that all required background screenings shall be conducted in accordance with this affidavit. I further understand that there may be additional local, state, and federal regulations that may require background screening, and that the Vendor will be solely responsible for complying with such legal requirements. Furthermore, the Vendor shall indemnify and hold Lee County harmless from any and all claims or actions resulting from failure to comply with this affidavit.

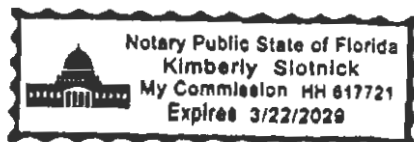


