Please confirm whether this "Invitation to Bid" is in reference to our proposal response or a separate form/document?
Answer	The "Invitation to Bid" referenced on Page 2 is a typographical error. Yes. It is intended to represent this Request for Proposal (RFP) solicitation. It is not a separate document.

2.	Due to busy nature of the Florida market, proven local resources are important for the success of this project. Please confirm that projects in Florida are preferred and will be scored favorably for Tab 1: Experience in Construction WWTP/WRFs and Tab 2: Experience with Site Development Projects.

The use of Sub-Proposer/Consultant under this solicitation is not allowed without prior written authorization from the County representative.
Answer	The use of a Sub-Proposer/Consultant by the Prime Vendor is not allowed without prior written authorization from the County representative.

5.	we are a dewatering subcontractor in your region, and we are interested in providing dewatering services for the above referenced project. Do you have the civil plan for this project?
Answer	There are no civil plans currently available for this project. See section 6.1 of the Special Conditions on page 18 of the solicitation. It is anticipated that the issuance of 30% design by the Consultant will coincide with the contracting of the CMAR for this project. A project schedule has been provided in Addendum 1.
