ACTION REQUESTED:

A. Approve Piggyback No. PB17035KLC Cleaning Supplies, Equipment and Custodial Related Products, Services and Solutions to utilize pricing on the Fresno Unified School District Contract No. 12-22, through the U.S. Communities Government Purchasing Alliance, to purchase cleaning supplies and equipment from Interline Brands, Inc. dba SupplyWorks on an as-needed basis as approved in the departments' annual adopted budgets.

The annual spend for FY15-16 was \$ 115,797.

Piggybacking on the Fresno Unified School District Contract No. 12-22, offered through the U.S. Communities Government Purchasing Alliance, for the purchase of these necessary cleaning products will authorize the County to purchase the supplies at a discount achieved through competitive solicitation.
