# TITLE:

### Background:

The State of Florida Contract Alternate Contract Source No. 52100000-16-ACS allows for the provision of flooring with related equipment, products, supplies, installation and services through the National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA) Master Agreement No. 121715-BPS, which went through the NJPA's competitive procurement process. The DMS Division of State Purchasing evaluated the Master Agreement and acknowledged in writing that use of the NJPA Master Agreement is cost-effective and in the best interest of the State. The County has used previous State of Florida Contracts in the past, which provided the benefit of procuring flooring with related equipment, products, supplies, installation and services at competitively solicited pricing for the purchase and installation of new carpet and flooring products (e.g. broadloom carpet, carpet tiles, rubber flooring, VCT, linoleum, sheet vinyl and walk-off mats, etc.) intended solely for use as a commercial grade floor coverings.
