On September 24, 2013, the Board of County Commissioners awarded Invitation to Bid No. B-130337 for the purchase of mowing for Lee County Parks and Recreation. The original term of the contract was for one-year with an option to renew for four additional one-year periods. Board approval will allow the purchasing of these services to continue uninterrupted until the formal solicitation process is completed.

Total expenditures for these services during Fiscal Year 2016-2017 were approximately \$355,206.58.
