



AGREEMENT FOR PIGGYBACK PURCHASE

THIS AGREEMENT FOR PIGGYBACK PURCHASE is made and entered into by and between the Lee County Board of County Commissioners, a political subdivision of the State of Florida ("County") and ESO Solutions, Inc., a Florida corporation authorized to do business in the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "Vendor".

WHEREAS, the Vendor entered into a contract with Marion County, Contract Number 18P-140 CNT, through their Solicitation No. RFP 18P-140 on the 18th day of September, 2018 for EMS Patient Software ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement is eligible for piggyback purchases; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to make purchases from the Vendor under the same terms and conditions of the Agreement..

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE FOREGOING AND THE MUTUAL COVENANTS CONTAINED HEREIN, IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

The County and the Vendor agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of the Agreement with respect to the County's purchases of software that will provide a patient care reporting system, computer aided dispatching integration, cardiac monitor integration, electronic interfaces, and health data exchange integration from the vendor during the term of the agreement from the effective date and any renewals or extensions thereof, with the except for the following:

1. The effective date shall be the date the Lee County Board of County Commissioners awarded the Solicitation to the Vendor.

2. The provision from Section 10.1 stating: “Commercial general liability insurance with a minimum of \$1 million per occurrence and \$1 million aggregate” shall be superseded by: “Commercial general liability insurance with a minimum of \$2 million per occurrence and \$2 million aggregate.”
3. The provision from Section 10.4 stating: “Computer processor/computer professional liability insurance ("Technology Errors and Omissions") covering the liability for financial loss due to error, omission or negligence of ESO, and Privacy and Network Security insurance ("Cyber") covering losses arising from a disclosure of confidential information, with a combined aggregate amount of \$3 million.” shall be superseded by: “Computer processor/computer professional liability insurance ("Technology Errors and Omissions") covering the liability for financial loss due to error, omission or negligence of ESO, and Privacy and Network Security insurance ("Cyber") covering losses arising from a disclosure of confidential information, with a combined aggregate amount of \$10 million.”
4. The provision from Section 11.1 stating: “ESO shall defend and indemnify Customer from any damages, costs, liabilities, expenses (including reasonable and actual attorney's fees) (“Damages”) actually incurred or finally adjudicated as to any third-party claim or action alleging that the Software delivered pursuant to this Agreement infringe or misappropriate any third party's patent, copyright, trade secret, or other intellectual property rights enforceable in the applicable jurisdiction (each an "Indemnified Claim”)” shall be superseded by: “ESO shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless Customer from any damages, costs, liabilities, expenses (including reasonable and actual attorney's fees) (“Damages”) arising from any third-party claim or action alleging that the Software delivered pursuant to this Agreement infringe or misappropriate any third party's patent, copyright, trade secret, or other intellectual property rights enforceable in the applicable jurisdiction (each an "Indemnified Claim”).”
5. The entirety of Section 12.2 shall be superseded by: “WITH THE EXCEPTION OF SECTION 12.3 (EXCEPTIONS TO THE LIMITATION OF LIABILITY), ESO'S MAXIMUM AGGREGATE LIABILITY FOR ALL CLAIMS OF LIABILITY ARISING OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH THIS AGREEMENT, SHALL NOT EXCEED THREE (3) TIMES THE FEES PAID BY CUSTOMER OR ON BEHALF OF CUSTOMER IN THE CASE OF A THIRD-PARTY PAYER UNDER THE APPLICABLE SOFTWARE SCHEDULE OR SOW GIVING RISE TO THE CLAIM WITHIN THE PRECEDING 24-MONTH PERIOD.”
6. The provision from Section 12.3 stating: “A PARTY'S LIABILITY SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE AMOUNT OF INSURANCE COVERAGE REQUIRED BY SECTION 10 FOR THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF CLAIMS: (1) CLAIMS ARISING FROM A PARTY'S GROSS NEGLIGENCE OR

WILLFUL MISCONDUCT; AND (II) CLAIMS ARISING FROM A BREACH OF CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION INCLUDING A BREACH OF PROTECTED HEALTH INFORMATION." shall be superseded by: "A PARTY'S LIABILITY TO THE OTHER PARTY SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE AMOUNT OF INSURANCE COVERAGE, ON A PER CLAIM BASIS, REQUIRED BY SECTION 10 FOR THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF CLAIMS: (1) CLAIMS ARISING FROM A PARTY'S GROSS NEGLIGENCE OR WILLFUL MISCONDUCT; AND (II) CLAIMS ARISING FROM A BREACH OF CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION INCLUDING A BREACH OF PROTECTED HEALTH INFORMATION."

7. Section 17.14 shall be deleted from this Agreement and be of no legal force or effect.
8. Section 17.22 shall be deleted from this Agreement and be of no legal force or effect.
9. The Parties agree to be bound by the provisions attached and incorporated hereto as "Exhibit A, Schedule of Subscription Fees." In the event of a conflict between the provisions in Exhibit A and the Agreement, the terms from Exhibit A shall take precedence.
