E: Approve Piggyback for Heavy Equipment and the Purchase of Walking Floor Trailers

I. MOTION REQUESTED

A) Approve Piggyback No. PB210073AEJ to utilize pricing on the Florida Sheriffs Association's Contract No. FSA20-EQU18.0 for Heavy Equipment with the 79 awarded vendors for the purchase of equipment, on an as needed basis as approved in the departments' annual adopted budgets, through the contract expiration date of September 30, 2023, and any renewals or extensions approved by the Florida Sheriffs Association.

B) Authorize the individual purchase of four walking floor trailers from Rechtien International Trucks, Inc. utilizing PB210073AEJ, Florida Sheriffs Association's Contract No. FSA20-EQU18.0 Heavy Equipment, in the amount of \$352,832.00.

C) Authorize the County Manager or designee to execute any contract documents associated with purchases on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners. Purchases in excess of \$100,000.00 will be presented to the Board for approval.

II. ITEM SUMMARY

Replaces four East Walking Floor Trailers valued at \$352,832.00 from Rechtien International through the Florida Sheriffs Association Contract for Heavy Equipment. The trailers are used to transport waste materials between collection, processing, and disposal facilities in Lee and Hendry Counties. These purchases are budgeted as the trailers are over fourteen years old and in poor condition. A market analysis was completed and the purchase under this contract represents a savings of \$12,201.08 per trailer for a total savings of \$48,804.32, and the surplus value of these assets is estimated to be roughly \$110,000.

III. BACKGROUND AND IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

A) Board Action and Other History

On April 22, 2020 the Florida Sheriffs Association advertised the Invitation to Bid for Heavy Equipment. The purpose of this bid was to establish contracts with manufacturers and manufacturer's authorized vendors for the purchase of equipment on a "no trade-in basis". 84 bids were submitted and after review by the Florida Sheriffs Association and Florida Sheriffs Association Fleet Advisory Committee, 79 qualified, responsive bidders were awarded the contract. Approval of the piggyback will allow for the purchase of resources necessary for the operational needs of the County, as approved in the department's annual adopted budgets.

This equipment is budgeted for in FY21 and is used to transport waste materials between collection, processing, and disposal facilities in Lee and Hendry Counties.
