TITLE: Approve Piggyback Purchase for Network and Security Operation Services

I. MOTION REQUESTED

A) Approve Piggyback No. PB240365KLB to utilize pricing on the Florida Department of Management Services/NASPO ValuePoint - Contract No. 43220000-NASPO-19-ACS for Data Communication Products and Services with Driven Technologies, Inc. dba Driven Technologies, for the purchase of network and security operations for 24/7 monitoring of enterprise-wide network server and voice infrastructure through the contract expiration date of September 30, 2024 and any renewals or extensions approved by Florida Department of Management Services, as approved in the departments' annual adopted budgets.
 B) Authorize the Chair to execute the contract documents on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners.
 C) Grant the County Manager or designee the authority to renew the contract and execute all associated documents, as approved in the departments' annual adopted budgets, if doing so is in the best interest of Lee County, and there are no cost increases associated with the renewal(s).

II. ITEM SUMMARY

Approves a piggyback purchase from Driven Technologies to use pricing on the Florida Department of Management Services/NASPO ValuePoint Contract. Driven Technologies will provide 24/7 enterprise-wide network and security monitoring, as well as datacenter, network and voice infrastructure support. The contract amount is \$638,491.00 and is for a term of one year.

A market analysis was completed and the purchase under this contract will represent a savings of \$34,814.00 or 5.17% from the previous contract.

III. BACKGROUND AND IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

A) Board Action and Other History

This is a replacement of contract PB210340BAG for Presidio Services Countywide which provided network monitoring and support. This replacement solution expands and improves the previous services to include a security operations center in addition to the network monitoring and support.

The expiration date of the Florida Department of Management Services/NASPO ValuePoint - Contract No. 43220000-NASPO-19-ACS for Data Communication Products and Services is September 30, 2024, but per the contract terms the duration of purchase order for recurring deliverable shall not exceed the expiration of the Contract by more than twelve months. The agreement with Driven Technologies, Inc. dba Driven Technologies will expire on September 5, 2025.
