3. QUESTIONS/ANSWERS

1.	We saw a couple of things on the contract that our legal will want to change. Will that take us out of consideration for the bid?
Answer	The County rarely deviates from its contract templates. The County could not make a determination for a deviation without knowing specific proposed modifications.
2.	We don't give away cleanings. That is a cost center for us. We would like to figure a way to do that with you. Would you be up for that?
Answer	After further review by the County, this article of the specification has been removed from this solicitation (see item 2 above).
3.	What kind of racks would you need to hold the bottles?
Answer	Plastic, wire, or wooden shelving units that provide for vertical stacking of water bottles. See included reference pictures (ATTACHMENT A) showing a variety of options. We do not require any specific unit type. Similar items providing this type of function would be suitable.
