NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE FOREGOING AND THE MUTUAL COVENANTS CONTAINED HEREIN, IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The requirement for an FBI fingerprint check using Integrated Automated Fingerprint Identification System under Article 3.5.18, Background Check, is removed.
