FIRST AMENDMENT OF THE DISASTER RECOVERY SERVICES FOR LEE COUNTY

AGREEMENT, made and entered into by and between the Lee County Board of County Commissioners, a political subdivision of the State of Florida ("County") and Crowder-Gulf Joint Venture, Inc. ("Vendor"), collectively, the "Parties."

WHEREAS, the County entered into an Agreement for disaster recovery services through Solicitation No. RFP220362BJB with Vendor on the 2nd day of October, 2022 ("Agreement"); and,

WHEREAS, after the execution of the agreement, it was determined that it would be in the best interests of the County to lower the cost per mile for alternate disposal sites outside of Lee County in Category A of the Exhibit B Fee Schedule; and,

WHEREAS, after the execution of the agreement, it was determined that it would be in the best interests of the County to reduce the number of additional services contracted for in Category B of the Exhibit B Fee Schedule; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to modify the Agreement pursuant to Article XV. MISCELLANEOUS of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE FOREGOING AND THE MUTUAL COVENANTS CONTAINED HEREIN, IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:
