COUNTY AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between the Lee County Board of County Commissioners, a political subdivision of the State of Florida ("County") and Crowder-Gulf Joint Venture, Inc. ("Vendor"), collectively, the "Parties."

WHEREAS, after the execution of the agreement, it was determined that it would be in the best interests of the County to add debris removal services for North Captiva Island and Cayo Costa Island, to the Exhibit B Fee Schedule of the Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to modify the Agreement pursuant to Article XV. MISCELLANEOUS of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE FOREGOING AND THE MUTUAL COVENANTS CONTAINED HEREIN, IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:
