Lee County Community Development is seeking to execute a single source for the purchase of support/maintenance service, enhancements, and upgrades of Selectron Technologies VoicePermits and WellPermits IVR Software systems; which includes an Administration Portal to accommodate added features. The features consist of Atlas Inspections mobilizing inspection results from the field, Atlas Insight a web-based location services and assignment management tool and SelectTXT for inspection scheduling by text from a mobile device. The PremierPro support includes telephone support during normal business hours, on-line technical diagnostic support, software upgrades, 24 hours a day 7 days per week, 365 days per year emergency support, development updates to customer's host database and back-end database, quarterly proactive system review, and out-of-cycle critical updates.
