Purchase of Centracs Annual Maintenance & Systems Upgrades

Description:

Lee County Department of Transportation is seeking to execute a sole source purchase for the Centracs System annual maintenance and system upgrades. The Centracs System is the Advanced Traffic Management System (ATMS) that allows the County to remotely monitor and maintain the signal system. All 443 existing traffic signals in Lee County are equipped with Econolite signal controllers which uses Centracs to monitor these traffic signals.

Intended Sole Source:

Econolite Systems, Inc

Justification for Sole Source Acquisition:

Lee County DOT have invested in the Advanced Traffic Management Operating software since the 1980's. Econolite is the sole developer of the Centracs System. The Centracs software upgrades can only be purchased through Econolite as the software is developed, registered and licensed for use only by Econolite.

Recommended Procurement Approach:

For the reason stated above, Lee County Procurement Management intends to utilize the Sole Source Procurement method to purchase from Econolite Systems, Inc. for supplying the above.
