

With regards to the price increase requested by Allied Universal Corporation for the supply of Sodium Hypochlorite to the County were pleased to supply the county with the following supporting reasons and documents.

The Bid Reference B200320DWJ for Sodium Hypochlorite for Water & Wastewater Facilities took place in 2020 and is reaching the first year anniversary September 1st., 2021 and the county would like to continue with the present bid for an additional year or ending August 31, 2022.
