
2. QUESTIONS/ANSWERS

1.	The construction plans loaded on your website on the wrong size. Can you please provide plans that are 11x17 or 24x36?
Answer	See attached plans.
2.	Will the casing be to a depth of 3,000' feet?
Answer	Please see page twenty-one (21) sheet M-502 Detail A Injection Well Detail of the plan set.
3.	Is there an engineers estimate on the project and is the estimate broken down by well and surface?
Answer	Per 13.3 of the Terms and Conditions, Lee County will not reveal engineering estimates or budget amounts for a project unless required by grant funding or unless it is in the best interest of the County.
4.	Where is the source water for the injection well?
Answer	Please see page five (5) sheet C-101 Aerial Site Plan of the plan set. Contractor to coordinate with County and field route temporary water piping from existing fire hydrant to IW-2.
5.	Per the surface work, where will it be completed and where are all the pipes and fittings currently near the work site going?
Answer	See plan set for details on surface facilities. The current pipes and fittings onsite now are part of the ongoing plant expansion.
6.	What is the driving access for the proposed work site? Will there be access to drive around the plant to access the work site?
Answer	The North gate is the planned entry point.
7.	When is the anticipate award and NTP for the project?
Answer	The anticipated award and NTP date for the project is June 2024.

8.	What if no one shows up to the second mandatory pre-bid meeting? Is the County still going to take this to bid?
Answer	Additional firms attended the second mandatory pre-bid meeting on 3/14/24 at 1:00 PM. All bids are due April 9, 2024, at 2:30 PM. Any bids received after this time will be considered late and will not be accepted.
