TITLE:	Award Contract for Wastewater Collections System Rehabilitation
I.	MOTION REQUESTED
	 A) Award Invitation to Bid No. B230154DWJ, Wastewater Collections System Rehabilitation to Miller Pipeline, LLC for the rehabilitation of the aging Lee County wastewater collection system, on an as-needed basis, for an initial term of three (3) years, as approved in the departments' annual adopted budget. B) Authorize the Chair to execute the contract documents on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners.
	C) Grant the County Manager or designee the authority to renew the contract, for up to three (3) additional years, and to execute all associated documents, as approved in the departments' annual adopted budgets, if doing so is in the best interest of Lee County, and there are no cost increases associated with the renewal.

ITEM SUMMARY П.

Awards a competitively bid contract to Miller Pipeline, LLC for wastewater collection system rehabilitation on an as-needed basis for an initial term of three years with three additional one-year terms at the option of the department. The average unit price increase is 35%. Total expenditures to provide these services for the last 12-month period were \$778,491.28.

BACKGROUND AND IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION III.

A) Board Action and Other History

> Procurement Management obtained one bid for the project known as Invitation to Bid No. B230154DWJ Wastewater Collections System Rehabilitation. After analyzing the submitted proposals, Miller Pipeline, LLC was determined to be the lowest responsible, responsive bidder. Current contract RFP170241DLK expired on January 6, 2023. On December 6, 2022 the Board approved a six (6) month extension to contract RFP170241DLK. The extension was necessary because the originally solicitation had to be re-advertised due to vendor contestment.

The annual contract allows Lee County Utilities to contract with a vendor for wastewater collection system rehabilitation and emergencies thus expediting repairs and reducing harmful impact to the health and safety of citizens.

Procurement conducted a price analysis between the existing contract and the new solicitation and found the average unit price increase of 35%.
