### Filling Sandbags



- 1. Sandbags should be filled ½ or ¾ full and should weigh about 30-40 pounds each.
- 2. Once filled, tie the sandbag near the top or twist the open end and tuck it under the bag.
- 3. Overfilling the sandbags or tying them too low makes them harder to stack and less flexible.



### Filling Sandbags

- 1. Sandbags should be filled ½ or ¾ full and should weigh about 30-40 pounds each.
- 2. Once filled, tie the sandbag near the top or twist the open end and tuck it under the bag.
- 3. Overfilling the sandbags or tying them too low makes them harder to stack and less flexible.



#### Laying Sandbags



- Start by placing a plastic sheet or tarp under the bags to improve water resistance.
- Place sandbags like brickwork, staggering rows so the joints do not line up.
- If the sandbag wall is going to be more than five (5) bags high, you will need to lay two (2) rows wide.
