Filling Sandbags



1. Sandbags should be filled $\frac{1}{2}$ or $\frac{2}{3}$ full and should weigh about 30-40 pounds each.
2. Once filled, tie the sandbag near the top or twist the open end and tuck it under the bag.
3. Overfilling the sandbags or tying them too low makes them harder to stack and less flexible.

Laying Sandbags

Start by placing a plastic sheet or tarp under the bags to improve water resistance.

Place sandbags like brickwork, staggering rows so the joints do not line up.

If the sandbag wall is going to be more than five (5) bags high, you will need to lay two (2) rows wide.
