Waiver Required: Parents will need to sign a waiver form the first day your child attends camp. **Waivers will be provided on site.**

Notice to Parents: **Rec Camp** daily activities may include: organized games, sports, crafts, and music. **This** is not a childcare program. Children are allowed to enter/leave at-will. LCPR is not able to provide meals or transportation. Lunch is not served. Please send your child with a bagged lunch, snacks and a water bottle.
