WHAT ASSISTANCE IS AVAILABLE?

Infrastructure

• Construction, repair, replacement or relocation of damaged public facilities and infrastructure such as bridges, water treatment facilities, water lines, water resources projects, roads, sewers, stormwater management systems, and energy production systems

WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

Lee County and Municipalities

WHAT ARE THE TERMS?

Eligible applicants may consider partnering with local utility providers, special taxing districts, etc., to submit applications that address critical infrastructure needs within each jurisdiction.

WHAT ASSISTANCE IS AVAILABLE?

HMGP Match Funding

• FEMA requires that awarded applicants provide 25% of the funding for awarded projects

WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

Applicants awarded Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) funds

WHAT ASSISTANCE IS AVAILABLE?

Planning

Creation of plans, including recovery and resiliency planning

WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

- Special Districts and School District
- Lee County and Municipalities
