CDBG-DR PUBLIC FACILITIES PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The CDBG-DR Public Facilities Program funds the acquisition, resilient construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation or installation of public facilities. Detailed award, scoring and application information can be found in the Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA).

Eligible Applicants

Lee County and Municipalities

Eligible applicants may partner with
non-profits, special districts or utility providers.

Activity Eligibility

Eligible activities must comply with the following requirements:

- Resilient and Green Building Design
- Meet a HUD National Objective
- Hurricane Ian Tieback or Unmet Mitigation Need

Example Activities

Some example public facility activities may include the acquisition, construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation or elevation of the following:

- facilities for persons with special needs such as facilities for the homeless or domestic violence shelters, nursing homes, or group homes for the disabled,
- Community facilities that provide a general public benefit and were directly or indirectly impacted by Hurricane Ian.



Minimum Funding Award: \$5 million per activity



Maximum Funding Award: \$50 million per activity
